1. Look I'm different too!

What you need (if you want people to write down their answers)

- Pens
- Paper

How to play

1. Divide the crowd into groups based on color of the shirt they are wearing
2. Ask them to answer the following questions verbally/or write down

Questions:

- What is your favourite cartoon character
- A personality trait you admire
- If you were given Rs 1 crore, what would you do with the money?
- Which bird do you feel is most like your personality?
- Where do you see yourself 10 years from now?

2. If you are happy and know it

What you need

1. Be able to play this song

How to play

1. Get everyone to stand in a circle
2. Play the song and get everyone to participate in the actions
3. When it is time to sing out the greetings, get groups to sing out the different greetings
(*Hello, Hola, Namaskar etc*)

3. Act it out

How to play

1. Divide the students into audience into groups of approximately 10 students.
2. The group then chooses a Bible story/ parable to act out. They get about 15 mins to prepare.
3. The hitch is they need to come up with a modern day version of the story and everyone must participate in the skit.

4. When is your birthday?

How to play

1. Have people arrange themselves in order of birth or in calendar months.
2. Instruct them that they cannot communicate with each other by talking or holding up fingers.
3. They can use sign language or their own sub language.
4. Give them about 5- 7 minutes to organize themselves. Once they are all lined up, ask a few random people their birthdays just to be sure.
