## **True Success - Activity**

Divide students into teams of 10-12 people each. Teams can be smaller if you have a smaller group of students.

The objective of the game is for one player from each team to have their teammates guess the word on the chit without using the word itself. Have the player pick up a chit and give their teammates clues that will help them guess the word. Once their team guesses the word, another person can come up and pick up the next chit and do the same until all 4 words have been guessed. If the team doesn't guess a word within 30 seconds, the same word is passed on to another person in the team. Of course, the person who has already seen the word cannot help the team guess the word.

- 1. Success
- 2. Achievement
- 3. Goal
- 4. Accomplish

Once the team guesses all 4 words, they will be given these words along with the remaining words on chits of paper and will need to organize it to form the sentence "Success is the achievement of the goal you set out to accomplish."

(If students are having a hard time putting the sentence together, you can give them a clue that the sentence gives you the definition of success, so it begins with "Success is ....")

The first team to guess all 4 words and form the sentence wins the game!

## **Connection to the topic:**

The students who win are the ones who accomplished the goal of the game. By playing the game and finishing the task assigned to them, they can practically see what it means to be successful.

Print the following table and cut out each word individually making 12 chits for each team that can be put together to form the sentence.
