

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Spiritual warfare does NOT involve:

- talking to satan/demons,
- cursing them and mocking them,
- or binding them

We simply bind a "specific work" of Satan that we have been given authority over.

Examples:

- Binding an 'addiction' (by prayerfully declaring and claiming that Jesus delivered me from the control of <u>every</u> sin on the Cross).
- Binding a high fever/cancer/allergy (by prayerfully declaring and claiming that Jesus already took <u>all</u> my diseases upon Himself on the Cross, to grant me healing from <u>every</u> disease).
- Binding the obstacle that is delaying my prayer (by prayerfully declaring and claiming that Jesus will answer every prayer in His <u>perfect time and perfect</u> <u>way</u>, and nothing has the authority to stop this).
- Casting out a demon that is possessing somebody (so that the person can have the opportunity to commit his life hundred percent to Jesus ... if the person chooses not to do so, the demon has the right to repossess the person).



All of these verses say that God will grant all our wishes.

Don't you think it was risky for God to promise Solomon 'ANYTHING?' What if Solomon had asked for something dangerous or silly?

Today, don't you think it is risky for God to include promises like, "Everything you ask for in prayer will be yours" (Mark 11:24)? What if someone asks for something dangerous or ridiculous?

• Mark 11:24: ______ you ask for in prayer will be yours, if you only have faith.

(We must trust completely in God, that He will give us only the very best.

We must have faith that God will not deprive us of anything good)

John 14:13,14: Ask me, and I will do ______
you ask. This way the Son will bring honor to the Father. I will do whatever you ask Me to do.

(Jesus answers our prayers so that His Father is honored.

So obviously, He will not answer anything that dishonors the Heavenly Father)

• John 15:7: Stay ______ to Me and let My teachings become part of you. THEN you can pray for whatever you want, and your prayer will be answered.

(WHEN we stay joined to the Lord, we will not feel any desire to pray selfishly or greedily)

 John 15:16: You did not choose Me. I chose you and sent you out to produce _____, the kind of fruit that will last. THEN My Father will give you whatever you ask for in My Name.

(WHEN we begin to bear fruit in our lives, THEN the Lord will answer 'all' our prayers—because THEN our priorities will be in the right order)

1 John 5:14,15: We are certain that God will hear our prayers when we ask for what ______ Him. And if we know that God listens when we pray, we are sure that our prayers have already been answered.

(The Lord promises to answer only those prayers that are according to His perfect will)

- God will say 'Yes' if I pray for a good future (Jeremiah 29:11).
- God will say 'Yes' if I pray for wisdom (James 1:5).
- God will say 'Yes' if I pray for unity (John 17:23).
- God will say 'Yes' if I pray for spiritual growth (Matthew 5:6).
- God will say 'Yes' if I pray for forgiveness for my sins (1 John 1:9).

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

What did Jacob pray to the Lord for, when he heard that Esau was on the way?



SCRIPTURE PORTION

Matthew 17:19-21; Mark 11:22-24; Isaiah 59:1,2





Mark 11:24

BIBLE PASSAGES:

Blockage 1:Unbelief

Matthew 15:28:

Jesus answered, "Dear woman, you really do have a lot of faith, and you will be given what you want." At that moment her daughter was healed.

Ask: According to this verse, why was the woman given what she wanted?

Matthew 17:19-21:

Later the disciples went to Jesus in private and asked Him, "Why couldn't we force out the demon?" Jesus replied: It is because you don't have enough faith! But I can promise you this. If you had faith no larger than a mustard seed, you could tell this mountain to move from here to there. And it would. Everything would be possible for you.

Ask: According to these verses, how much faith is needed to move mountains?

Romans 12:3:

... God has dealt to each one a measure of faith.

Ask: According to this verse, what must we do to get "Faith no larger than a mustard seed?"

God has given each of us a measure of faith. It is like a small seed of mustard or tamarind. It needs to be nourished and watered, just like an ordinary seed. Otherwise the little seed will shrivel up.

James 1:6-8:

But when you ask for something, you must have faith and not doubt. Anyone who doubts is like an ocean wave tossed around in a storm. If you are that kind of person, you can't make up your mind, and you surely can't be trusted. So don't expect the Lord to give you anything at all.

If the seedling of faith is getting bigger and stronger in your heart, You will see many answers to prayer.

But if the weeds of doubt and unbelief are growing bigger and stronger, God Himself promises that He won't answer your prayers!

Blockage 2: Not Exercising Spiritual Authority

Matthew 17:19-21:

Later the disciples went to Jesus in private and asked Him, "Why couldn't we force out the demon?" Jesus replied: It is because you don't have enough faith! But I can promise you this. If you had faith no larger than a mustard seed, you could tell this mountain to move from here to there. And it would. Everything would be possible for you.

Ask: According to these verses, what must we do with our mustard seed of faith?

Matthew 21:21,22:

But Jesus said to them, "If you have faith and don't doubt, I promise that you can do what I did to this tree. And you will be able to do even more. You can tell this mountain to get up and jump into the sea, and it will. If you have faith when you pray, you will be given whatever you ask for."

Ask: According to these verses, what must we do with our mustard seed of faith?

Mark 11:22-24:

Jesus told His disciples: Have faith in God! If you have faith in God and don't doubt, you can tell this mountain to get up and jump into the sea, and it will. Everything you ask for in prayer will be yours, if you only have faith.

Ask: According to these verses, what must we do with our mustard seed of faith?

Ephesians 6:12:

We are not fighting against humans. We are fighting against forces and authorities and against rulers of darkness and powers in the spiritual world."

Sometimes evil spirits directly bring a problem or sickness into our lives.

In such cases we must use the spiritual authority that God has given us, so that our prayer will be answered.

Blockage 3: Unconfessed sin

Isaiah 59:1,2:

The Lord hasn't lost His powerful strength; He can still hear and answer prayers. Your sins are the road block between you and your God. That's why He doesn't answer your prayers or let you see His face.

Ask: According to these verses, what is the roadblock between you and your God?

1 Peter 3:12:

The Lord watches over everyone who obeys Him, and He listens to their prayers. But He opposes everyone who does evil."

Ask: According to this verse, whose prayers does God ignore?

If you want God to answer your prayers, do away with sin and ask God for forgiveness.

When sin goes, God will begin to answer you and guide you in all your ways.

Video Presentation

Video: Faith

Duration: 4 minutes and 40 seconds

According to the video, why is it easier to trust the Mercedes Benz than the Beetle?

If I were driving a Mercedes Benz outside city limits, would I feel worried about a breakdown? Why or Why not?

What if I were a villager who only knows about trucks? Would I feel worried driving the Benz to a far-off place? Why or Why not?

The Benz, the Villager and the Car Enthusiast

• **The Villager** trusts the Benz based on how it looks on the outside.

The Car Enthusiast trusts the Benz based on his knowledge of the quality and reliability of the Benz engine and other internal parts.

• The Villager trusts the Benz as long as the road is smooth.

The Car Enthusiast trusts the Benz even when the road is reduced to a rutted pathway of stone and gravel.

The Difference is that one of them barely knows the Benz, while the other knows it intimately!

God, the Immature Christian and the Mature Christian

• The Immature Christian trusts God based on how strongly he can feel God's presence, and on how clearly he can see God answering all his prayers.

The Mature Christian trusts God based on his Knowledge of God. He knows about how loving and reliable God is, how powerful He is, and how wise He is.

• **The Immature Christian** trusts God as long as all the circumstances in his life are smooth.

The Mature Christian trusts God even in the dark storms of life because he knows how loving, reliable, wise and powerful God is.

The Difference is that one of them barely knows God, while the other knows Him intimately!

How to Know the Benz Intimately:

- Read everything you can about the car, and get to know all about it.
- Spend time driving it and get a personal feel of it.

• The more you drive it, the more you will know how it will respond in different situations.

How to Know God Intimately:

- Get to KNOW ABOUT Him: You must read the Bible everyday and get to know all about Him.
- Get to KNOW HIM PERSONALLY: Next, you must get to know Him personally by spending time with Him. Talk to Him informally through prayer, and then wait silently and listen for His voice. Allow Him to start speaking to you in your heart.
- Pray in TONGUES and seek the INTERPRETATION: Make it a point to pray in tongues, so that your spirit is strengthened. Ask the Lord to interpret back to you what you have prayed, so that you may know what the Lord is imparting personally to you.

Let us assume that I have been praying with active faith for 20 years. But I still have not received an answer to my prayer. Do you think my prayer will ever be answered?

Mark 11:24: Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you <u>receive</u> them, and <u>you will</u> <u>have</u> them."

- The word, "receive" comes from the Greek word, LAMBANO, which means "to receive now" (present tense). Jesus said that "when" you pray, you must believe that you "receive" your answer at that moment.
- He then says we will "have" them. "Have" comes from, ESOMAI, which means "to possess later" (future tense).

Sometimes your prayer will take a long time to bear fruit!

Blockage 2: Not Exercising Spiritual Authority

Jesus says that if I speak to the mountain, it will move. Does this mean I can speak whatever I want and move anything I want?

IMPORTANT NOTE:

Spiritual warfare does NOT involve:

- talking to satan/demons
- cursing them and mocking them
- or binding them

We simply "speak to the mountain" (to the "specific problem" that sat an has brought upon us)

Examples:

- Speaking to the 'addiction' (and prayerfully declaring and claiming that Jesus delivered me from the control of <u>every</u> sin on the Cross).
- Speaking to the high fever/cancer/allergy (and prayerfully declaring and claiming that Jesus already took <u>all</u> my diseases upon Himself on the Cross, to grant me healing from <u>every</u> disease).
- Speaking to the obstacle that is delaying my prayer(and prayerfully declaring and claiming that Jesus will answer every prayer in His <u>perfect time and perfect</u> <u>way</u>, and nothing has the authority to stop this).

We speak to a demon directly, <u>in Jesus' Name</u>, only when we are casting it out of a possessed person (so that the person can have the opportunity to commit his life hundred percent to Jesus ... if the person chooses not to do so, the demon has the right to repossess the person).


