ROLE DESCRIPTION

Your responsibilities as a Catalyst Team Member will include but are not limited to the following:

- Serve under the leadership of the Catalyst Coordinator to serve children in the schools where the Catalyst program is being run.
- Ensure you are punctual and regular in taking the class assigned to you in the respective schools. Teach your classes using the Catalyst Curriculum.
- Spend quality time preparing the lessons to be taught.
- Use creative methods and tools to teach children.
- Co-ordinate with/inform the Catalyst Coordinator and the school(s) early if you are unable to take class on any given day due to an unforeseen emergency.
- Send your weekly report of the classes taken to the Catalyst Coordinator in a timely manner
- Update the Catalyst consolidated excel sheet of the report of the classes taken in all schools each week.

- Ensure that Catalyst team staff and volunteers have the requisite permission (police verification / documents if required by the schools).
- Counsel, disciple, and mentor children in the schools when required.
- Assist in writing and refining the Catalyst curriculum.
- Assist in introducing the Catalyst program to new schools in Bangalore and support efforts to get them to sign up for the program.
- Counsel, disciple, and mentor children in the schools when required.
- Participate in Catalyst prayer time every week and pray for different needs of the ministry, children, and schools.

QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

- A definite and discernible call to minister to children and teenagers.
- A good testimony among your current local church community with a demonstratable strong personal walk with God.
- A strong, demonstratable emphasis on personal study of God's Word and a strong personal walk with the Holy Spirit.
- A strong, demonstratable ability to teach life-skills and preach God's Word with clarity, and simplicity, to children and teenagers.
- Alignment with APC's Statement of Faith (see apcwo.org).
- A Bachelor's degree (any field) is required; a degree in psychology is highly preferred.
- A theological background is also preferred, with the ability to attend all of APC's Weekend Schools and potentially take courses at APC-Bible College.
- Demonstrable experience in writing life skills curriculum or related material for children and teenagers.
- Prior ministry experience with children and teenagers in a local church or Christian ministry is required.
- Prior experience in working in teams of five or more people, both as a team member and as a team leader, either in a professional or local church environment.
- Including the above requirements, preference will be given to (A) those who have graduated with a 3-year degree from APC Bible College or (B) those who have actively served/volunteered at APC for a minimum of 3 years and have attended all of APC's Weekend Schools.

KNOWLEDGE & SKILLS REQUIREMENTS

- Have a heart to serve and must be passionate to minister to children.
- Must have good communication, coordination and decision-making skills.
- Effective written and verbal communication skills.
- Must be self-Motivated.
