VISION

To plan, develop vision and strategy for College Outreaches in Bangalore. Over time, equip and build highly motivated APC teams engaging in the outreaches.

SCOPE

Currently, Campus Elevates are APC's college outreaches in Bangalore. Campus groups are discipleship groups on college campuses. Coordinator to begin with continuing these programs with excellence, developing them further and initiating additional ways to reach college students in the city.

ROLE DESCRIPTION

The role of the Campus Outreach Coordinator will include but are not limited to the following:

- Identify new colleges for Campus Elevates, Campus Groups and other activities to serve college students.
 - Continue coordinating existing Campus Elevates, Campus Groups and maintain the Calendar on church website.
 - Create and maintain content for Campus Elevates, Campus Groups and any other programs initiated (See <https://apcwo.org/resources/youth-outreach>)
 - Coordinate with APC Volunteers to keep them well informed of programs, provide required training, develop guidelines, conduct volunteer meetings, visit various locations to meet with potential volunteers etc.
 - Coordinate with APC Staff: Senior Pastor for approval of content, Media team for promotions, IT team for website updating, Admin for all necessary equipment required, Pastors for volunteer selection from locations, accounting team as necessary etc.
 - Regular documenting and reporting to Senior Pastor (brief report, attendance at programs, pictures, data of interested students, follow-up programs, weekly reports, etc)
 - Special events on occasions – Induction programs during new academic year, Christmas, Friendship day etc. are opportunities to hold evangelistic programs on college campuses. Plan suitable events.

- Develop vision and strategy – improving existing programs and adding new ones to expand the reach and improve impact. Keep website updated.
- Continuously observe the programs, processes, people, etc. to improve and bring in excellence in execution.
- Report directly to the Senior Pastor and Head of Operations (for organizational matters).

QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE REQUIREMENTS

- A definite and discernible call to serve young people, specifically, college students.
- A good testimony among your current local church community with a demonstrable strong personal walk with God.
- A strong, demonstrable emphasis on personal study of God's Word and a close walk with the Holy Spirit.
- A strong, demonstrable ability to minister God's Word with clarity, and simplicity and in the power of the Holy Spirit.
- Alignment to APC's Statement of Faith (see apcwo.org website)
- A Bachelor's degree (any field) is required. An advanced (Masters level or higher) degree (any field) preferred. Individuals will be required to attend all of APC's Weekend Schools. Individuals may also be requested to attend courses at APC-Bible College to help provide necessary spiritual equipping.
- Prior involvement in local church or Christian ministry for at least 3 years serving young people.
- Prior experience in working in teams of five or more people, both as a team member and as a team leader, either in a professional or local church environment.
- Including the above requirements, preference will be given to (A)those who have graduated with a 3-year degree from APC Bible College or (B)those who have actively served/volunteered at APC for a minimum of 5 years and have attended all of APC's Weekend Schools.

KNOWLEDGE & SKILLS REQUIREMENTS

- Must have exceptional leadership qualities, good communication skills, and exceptional interpersonal skills. Must be able to understand and work well with people of diverse temperaments, backgrounds and skill-sets.
 - Good understanding of what is important to the youth and able to address such matters from a Biblical perspective.
 - Must be a good communicator of the Word of God and able to minister the Word effectively to young people.
 - Must have good computer skills.
