SUMMARY

As a Children's Church Pastor at APC, you will make arrangements for smooth running of the Sunday service. Identify and train Children Church Ministers (CCM), Roster CCM two months in advance. Along with teaching the curriculum ensure that the CCM are praying and mentoring the children in their classes. Oversee the smooth running and assist the CC coordinators at different locations.

RESPONSIBILITIES

Your work will typically involve the following:

- Plan, Prepare and Ensure the Smooth Running of Sunday Services
- Identify and Train CC Ministers
- Ensure the completion of writing the CC Curriculum and updating the topics already written.
- Plan and Organize CC programs on Sunday that reiterates the topic being taught or the CC Vision.
- Plan and Organize the Kids Conference.

- A Theological Degree.
- Prior ministry experience with children
- Have a heart to serve.
- Passionate to minister to children.
- Prior experience of writing curriculum.
- Have good organizational and decision making skills.
- Effective written and verbal communication skills.

- Organized and self-Motivated.
- Willingness to consistently train and upgrade oneself on new modes of ministering to children.
