### Practical Aspects:

#### 1. Worship the Lord, clothed with holiness

Psalm 29:1,2 Psalm 24:3-6 1 John 1:6-10 1 John 3:21

Prepare your heart, get rid of sin, clear your conscience. In order to experience communion with God, there must be a cleansing of the filth of the world.

Recognize that you are the righteousness of God.

Worship God with a free conscience

#### 2. The Psalm 95 Pattern

Psalm 95:1-7 Psalm 100:4

Praise, Thanksgiving à Worship

Praise and thanksgiving is our entrance into God's courts – not about God coming down to visit us.

#### 3. Express your reverence, love and adoration of God with words

I can use the Bible as my "Book of worship". There are several passages in the Bible that I can use in personal worship

Revelation 4:8,11; 5:12-13; 7:9-12; 11:15,17

1 Chronicles 29:10-14

Psalm 36:5-7; 40:5; 63:1-2; 115:1-3

#### 4. Worship with song, psalms, instruments, music

Psalm 66:1-4 2 Chronicles 29:25-30

Ephesians 5:18-20 Colossians 3:16,17

#### 5. Worship with offering

Deuteronomy 26:10 Psalm 96:8-9 Exodus 23:15

Worshipful giving is our response to the blessings He has given to us.

### Postures In Worship

Bowing down Genesis 24:26, 48, 52

Kneeling Psalm 95:6

Stand up and worship Exodus 33:10

Fall down as one dead Ezekiel 1:28, 3:23, 43:3, 44:4 Revelation 1:17

Lifting hands Nehemiah 8:6

Lifting hands has a lot of significance: Psalm 28:2, Psalm 63:4 Psalm 134:2 Psalm 141:2 Psalm 143: 6 1

Timothy 2:8 (expresses need for comfort, surrender, offering of self, desire for Him, celebration of Him)

### Moods in Worship

Be still Psalm 46:10-11

Be silent Habakkuk 2:20

Worship is beholding God's beauty Psalm 27:4

Surrender 1 Timothy 2:8



Wanting more of God Psalm 42:1-2 63:1,8  
Repentance Isaiah 6:1-8  
Humility

Worship differs from praise in that typically praise is exuberant and is a celebration. While worship is typically full of reverence. We enter His gate and come into His courts with thanksgiving and praise. We bow before His throne in worship.
