

Outpouring 2008 Meetings : Review

Dear Church Family and Friends:

This past Saturday, August 23rd, was our last evening of the Outpouring 2008 meetings, with about 50 evenings, starting end May through to last Saturday.

We did a quick survey and there were several who indicated that they had received healing, supernatural breakthrough in certain areas of life, and were spiritually refreshed during the course of these meetings. We also know that there were several who were saved and brought in to a relationship with Jesus.

While the meetings have ended, our journey into revival continues. We must rediscover the glory of the former house (The Early Church) and press in to the greater glory that God has ordained for the latter house (The End-Time Church). This journey still continues.

In Genesis 26:15-33, we have the historic account of Isaac re-digging the wells of his father Abraham which the Philistines had closed up. Using this as an illustration (allegory), Ps. Ashish shared the final message on "Re-digging Ancient Wells". Isaac could have walked past the wells and built monuments near each one to remember that at one point in history these wells had life giving water. Many of us do this today. We build monuments of theological explanations on why the ancient wells that once watered the Early Church are not giving their water. Rather the Spirit's call is loud and clear – that we need to re-dig the ancient wells which the enemy has stopped. (1)We need to re-dig the ancient well of a greater measure of the presence and power of God in the house of God. (2)We need to re-dig the ancient well of the supernatural – a greater measure of the demonstration of signs, wonders and miracles. (3)We need to re-dig the ancient well where every believer is empowered and released to impact the world, resulting in souls being added and multiplied in to the Kingdom of God. (4)We need to re-dig the ancient well of unity and revival in the citywide church, until the church in the city is 'one'. Like Isaac, we will have to work past contention ('Esek' vs 20), and accusation ('Sitnah, vs 21), until we arrive at fruitfulness ('Reheboth' vs 22) and press on to perfection ('Sheeba' vs 33) where God declares His covenant and people recognize the good hand of the Lord upon us.

Every prophecy, dream and vision which the Lord has spoken during this season will be fulfilled.

Our journey in re-digging these ancient wells continues.

Let's seek Him until He comes and rains on us (Hosea 6:3).
