WoL 2011: 2011 A Year of Harvest Reaping rewards of what you have sown

Psalm 126:5,6

5 Those who sow in tears Shall reap in joy.

6 He who continually goes forth weeping, Bearing seed for sowing, Shall doubtless come again with rejoicing, Bringing his sheaves with him.

Jeremiah 5:24

They do not say in their heart, "Let us now fear the LORD our God, Who gives rain, both the former and the latter, in its season. He reserves for us the appointed weeks of the harvest."

What you have sown in tears, you will reap with joy.

You who have continually gone forth weeping, bearing your seed for sowing, will doubtless come again with rejoicing, bringing in your harvest with you.

This is your appointed year of harvest.

Four main areas to expect harvest

God of the Harvest

Genesis 8:22 "While the earth remains, Seedtime and harvest, Cold and heat, Winter and summer, And day and night Shall not cease."

Zechariah 8:12

'For the seed shall be prosperous, The vine shall give its fruit, The ground shall give her increase, And the heavens shall give their dew— I will cause the remnant of this people To possess all these.

God celebrates the Harvest

Feast of Firstfruits (Leviticus 23:9-14)

they brought the firstfruit of the barley at the Feast of Firstfruits

Feast of Pentecost (Feast of harvest, Feast of Weeks)

Exodus 23:16, Exodus 34:22, Leviticus 23:15-21

Essentially a harvest celebration, the term weeks was used to describe the time period from the grain harvest to the barley harvest and finally to the wheat harvest. It is called the Feast of Weeks because God specifically told the sons of Jacob that they were to count seven sevens of weeks (seven complete weeks) from Firstfruits (Leviticus 23:15; Deuteronomy 16:9), and then on the "morrow" this fourth feast was to be observed (Luke 23:16). Seven sevens of weeks are forty-nine days. Add one additional day ("on the morrow"), and it brings the total number of days to fifty. This fourth feast was to occur precisely fifty days after Firstfruits (Christ's resurrection). Therefore, the feast was given the name "Pentecost" (Acts 2:1) which means "fifty."

Four main areas to expect your harvest

not the only areas where God will give you harvest, but key areas:

1, A harvest of all that you have sown in the Spirit



Galatians 6:7-10

7 Do not be deceived, God is not mocked; for whatever a man sows, that he will also reap.

8 For he who sows to his flesh will of the flesh reap corruption, but he who sows to the Spirit will of the Spirit reap everlasting life.

9 And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart. 10 Therefore, as we have opportunity, let us do good to all, especially to those who are of the household of faith.

We sow to the Spirit in many ways, through prayers, sowing God's Word into our heart, walking in righteousness, submitting to God's will, etc.

2, A harvest of your generous and sacrificial giving

Hebrews 6:10

For God is not unjust to forget your work and labor of love which you have shown toward His name, in that you have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

Proverbs 3:9,10

9 Honour the LORD with thy substance, and with the firstfruits of all thine increase: 10 So shall thy barns be filled with plenty, and thy presses shall burst out with new wine.

Malachi 3:9,10 2 Corinthians 9:6-8

3, A harvest in your professional life

Psalm 128

- 1 Blessed is every one who fears the LORD, Who walks in His ways.
- 2 When you eat the labor of your hands, You shall be happy, and it shall be well with you.

Deuteronomy 28:12

The LORD will open to you His good treasure, the heavens, to give the rain to your land in its season, and to bless all the work of your hand. You shall lend to many nations, but you shall not borrow.

4, A harvest of souls into the Kingdom

Acts 2:41,47

41 Then those who gladly received his word were baptized; and that day about three thousand souls were added to them.

47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved.

Feast of Firstfruits (Christ's resurrection)



Fifty days later was the Feast of Harvest (also called Feast of Pentecost). Three thousand souls were added on one day!

Matthew 9:37 Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest truly is plentiful, but the laborers are few.

What must I do during harvest time?

Fight for your harvest

Fight for your harvest through focused faith.

Every harvest in your life will require a battle.

Remember that the God of the harvest is on your side:

Malachi 3:11 "And I will rebuke the devourer for your sakes, So that he will not destroy the fruit of your ground, Nor shall the vine fail to bear fruit for you in the field," Says the LORD of hosts;

Harvest time is busy time

Get ready to be busy as your harvest begins to come in.

Proverbs 10:5 He who gathers in summer is a wise son; He who sleeps in harvest is a son who causes shame.

Harvest time is a messy time

Things may be in a state of flux, a little "out of order", messy – but permit that, because it is harvest time.

Prepare to share

Leviticus 19:9,10

9 'When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not wholly reap the corners of your field, nor shall you gather the gleanings of your harvest.

10 And you shall not glean your vineyard, nor shall you gather every grape of your vineyard; you shall leave them for the poor and the stranger: I am the LORD your God.

Leviticus 23:22 ←

'When you reap the harvest of your land, you shall not wholly reap the corners of your field when you reap, nor shall you gather any gleaning from your harvest. You shall leave them for the poor and for the stranger: I am the LORD your God.'

Sow and Reap in one year

God is able to give you a harvest in one year.

A harvest in one year

Genesis 26:12,13

12 Then Isaac sowed in that land, and reaped in the same year a hundredfold; and the LORD blessed him.

13 The man began to prosper, and continued prospering until he became very prosperous;

Purposefully sow and reap this year.

Isaiah 32:20 Blessed are you who sow beside all waters, Who send out freely the feet of the ox and the donkey.

- 2, Write down what you need to do to be ready to receive your harvest
- 3, Pronounce "harvest time" over our church, across churches in our city and the nation
