# The state of our nation

29 states and 7 union territories of India. 647 Districts including 7 union territories.





As per media reports, there are about 8 Tier I cities (Ahmedabad, Bangalore, Chennai, Delhi, Hyderabad, Kolkata, Mumbai, Pune), 26 Tier II cities, 33 Tier III cities and over 5,000 Tier IV towns, while there are more than 638,000 villages in the country. [1]

## **Demographics**

India is second among the world's most populated countries. With its current population of more than **1.21 billion people** (As per Census of India 2011), the country is estimated to surpass China and become the most populous country in the world.

Literacy rate: Total: 74.04 % Females: 65.46 % Males: 82.14 %

Median age: Total: 26.2 years Female: 26.9 years Male: 25.6 years

**50% of the population is 25 years and below** (Census of India, 2011).

Hindi, being the national language of the country, most Indians (41.03 %) speak the Hindi language (dialects).

Nearly 22% of India's population live below national poverty line. [3]

#### **Indian Economy [4]**

Three major sectors contribute to the Indian economy and the GDP of the country. These are: (i) agriculture - which includes crops, milk, animal husbandry, fishing, forestry and some other activities. (ii) industry - which includes several manufacturing sub-sectors, and (iii) services - which includes retail, construction, software, communication, IT, banking, healthcare and other economic activities.



**Agriculture** - In agriculture production, India ranks second in the world. Agriculture and related activities accounts for about 18% of the total Gross Domestic Product (GDP) and also employ approximately 50% of the total workforce of the country. The agriculture sector's contribution to the economy has been increasing with every financial year.


*Industry* - Industry contributes about 26% of the GDP and 22% of the total workforce in India is associated with industry sector. There are many sub-sectors in industry which generate revenue for this sector such as petroleum, engineering, pharmaceuticals, mining, textile and many more.

**Services** - The Indian service sectors account for about 60% of the total GDP. Information technology (IT), IT enabled services (ITeS) and e-commerce has led to the growth of this sector. The services sector has also attracted the highest amount of foreign equity with the government's foreign direct investment (FDI) policies.

#### Challenges facing the Indian economy:

**Population explosion:** The rising population weighs the success of the Indian economy and puts lot of stress on economic infrastructure of the nation.

**Poverty:** As per records of National Planning Commission, 36 crore people (21.9% of total population) were living below the poverty line in India in 2012. [8]






**Unemployment:** The increasing population is pressing hard on economic resources as well as job opportunities. Indian government schemes make negligible difference.

**Rural Urban Divide:** It is said that India lies in villages. Even today when there is lot of talk about migration to cities, 70% of the Indian population still lives in villages. There is a very stark difference in the pace of rural and urban growth.

# **Spiritual Activity**

As per the religious **census data of 2011**, released by the Registrar General and Census Commissioner, the total population in the country in 2011 was 121.09 crore. Hindu population is 96.63 crore (**79.8 percent**); Muslim 17.22 crore (**14.2 percent**); Christian 2.78 crore (**2.3 percent**); Sikh 2.08 crore (1.7 percent); Buddhist 0.84 crore (0.7 percent); Jain 0.45 crore (0.4 percent), Other religions and persuasions (ORP) 0.79 crore (0.7 percent) and religion not stated 0.29 crore (0.2 percent).

If you look at the distribution of Christian population across India [5]:



As we can see, a major part of North India has less than 1% Christian population, and a good portion of the rest of India well below 5%.



Hence our focus should be on bringing the Gospel to those parts of India that still need strong Christian witness. North India is strategically important in completing the unfinished task of world evangelization.

# What is happening-some Indian States [7]:

#### Bihar



Traditionally know as the 'missionaries graveyard', Bihar is one of the least-evangelized megapopulations in the world. There are 24 districts (accounting for 57 million people) that are less than 0.03% Christian.


A lot of work needs to be done.

- ✓ Bihar is 90% rural, one of the world's highest rates. Outreach and church planting must focus on towns and villages, with sensitivity to the close-knit community dynamics therein.
- ✓ Bihar is a young population, with as high as 60% of the population under 25 years old.
- ✓ Unreached peoples. There are 22 groups of over 100,000 that are unreached and as yet unengaged.




Among others, Rev. Augustine Jebakumar of Gospel Echoing Missionary Society (GEMS) and the Friends Missionary Prayer Band (FMPB) have done great pioneering work in Bihar.

#### **Gujarat**



While there is a good response among some of the tribal villages, still a lot needs to be done. God has been using Bishop Devadoss, Sharing Love Mission, to do a significant work among the Bhil tribals. About 620 Bhil villages have been reached. Bhils are one of the largest tribal groups in India.

## Jammu & Kashmir



Almost all peoples in Jammu and Kashmir are unreached. There is also the threat of Islamic militancy in this region.




# <u>Punjab</u>



From report on the ground, Punjab, especially in the rural parts seems to be experiencing a rapid growth of the Gospel. However there is a great need for strong teaching and discipling of new believers.

## Rajasthan



The Church has seen some growth in the city of Jaipur, but most of the state remains without much impact. Many tribal groups are responding to the Gospel but progress is slow. Higher castes, especially Rajputs (who originated from Rajasthan) and Jats, show almost negligible response to the gospel.

#### #5, Provide missionary care (financially empowering those on the ground)

# #6, Support APC's Publications ministry

- 8 Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying: "Whom shall I send, And who will go for Us?" Then I said, "Here am I! Send me."
