

SECTION SEVEN : REDEEMED IN CHRIST

57. IN HIM WE HAVE REDEMPTION

Ephesians 1:7

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.

1 Corinthians 1:30

But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption.

Greek words when translated convey 'redemption.'

redeem, bought

Agaridzo (Gr.)= 'bought', 'to go to market'. Used to describe the market place, specifically the slave market.

Exagridzo (Gr.)= to purchase a slave out of a slave market.

ransom, redeem

Lutroo (Gr.)= to set a captive free by the payment of a ransom.

Antilutron (Gr.) = a redemption price, a ransom.

Redemption apolutrosis (Gr.)= to pay a ransom in order to return us to our former state.

Redemption is to be purchased, ransomed, and restored.

58. REDEEMED BY HIS BLOOD

Ephesians 1:7

In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins, according to the riches of His grace.

Colossians 1:12–14

12 Giving thanks to the Father who has qualified us to be partakers of the inheritance of the saints in the light.

13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,

14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.

1 Timothy 2:5,6

**5 For there is one God and one Mediator between God and men, the Man Christ Jesus,
6 who gave Himself a ransom for all, to be testified in due time.**

Hebrews 9:12

Not with the blood of goats and calves, but with His own blood He entered the Most Holy Place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption.

59. HIS BLOOD SPEAKS

Hebrews 12:22-24

**22 But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem, to an innumerable company of angels,
23 to the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven, to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made perfect,
24 to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than that of Abel.**

In the spiritual realm, blood speaks.

The blood of Abel cried out for something to be done.

The blood of Jesus announces that the work has been completed.

The blood of Abel cries out for justice.

The blood of Jesus proclaims that God's justice has been fully satisfied and redemption has been provided.

60. DELIVERED FROM SATAN'S DOMINION

Colossians 1:13-14

**13 He has delivered us from the power of darkness and conveyed us into the kingdom of the Son of His love,
14 in whom we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of sins.**

61. GOD'S PROPERTY

1 Corinthians 6:20

For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

Revelation 5:9,10

**9 And they sang a new song, saying: "You are worthy to take the scroll, and to open its seals; For You were slain, and have redeemed us to God by Your blood out of every tribe and tongue and people and nation,
10 and have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth."**

62. REDEEMED FROM THE CURSE OF THE LAW

Galatians 3:13

Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree").

Galatians 4:4,5

**4 But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law,
5 to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons.**

63. REDEEMED FROM EVERY LAWLESS DEED

Titus 2:14

Who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.

64. REDEEMED FROM THIS PRESENT EVIL AGE

Galatians 1:3-4

3 Grace to you and peace from God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ,

4 who gave Himself for our sins, that He might deliver us from this present evil age, according to the will of our God and Father.

65. REDEEMED FROM THE FEAR OF DEATH

Hebrews 2:14,15

14 Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil,

15 and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.

66. REDEEMED FROM GENERATIONAL BONDAGES

1 Peter 1:18-19

18 Knowing that you were not redeemed with corruptible things, like silver or gold, from your aimless conduct received by tradition from your fathers,

19 but with the precious blood of Christ, as of a lamb without blemish and without spot.

67. RESTORED UNTO GOD

Romans 5:11

And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation.

Atonement Katallage (Gr.)= Exchange—of the business of moneychangers, exchanging equivalent values.

= Adjustment of a difference, reconciliation, restoration to favor, in the New Testament refers to the restoration of the favor of God to sinners that repent and put their trust in the expiatory death of Christ.

68. CHRIST IS OUR REDEMPTION

1 Corinthians 1:30

But of Him you are in Christ Jesus, who became for us wisdom from God—and righteousness and sanctification and redemption.

69. LET THE REDEEMED SAY SO!

Psalm 107:2

Let the redeemed of the LORD say so, whom He has redeemed from the hand of the enemy.

70. TESTIFY TO THE BLOOD

Revelation 12:11

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony, and they did not love their lives to the death.
