GREATER GLORY – We are continuing to move into greater glory. Haggai 2:9 Ephesians 5:27

Word of the Lord 2022 GO, TAKE YOUR MOUNTAIN! Conquer your giants! Occupy your inheritance!

Joshua 14:6-15

For Caleb the mountain was his inheritance.

It was God's promised inheritance to him.

It was kept away from him for a long time.

Also, there were giants in the land he had to drive out, to occupy what was promised to him.

"your mountain" – represents something that God wants you to have, to possess, in the current season of your life.

It could be a life dream, a life assignment that you have been carrying in your heart, that He wants you to step into this year.

It could represent, a place of accomplishment, a place of success that you desire to be at in this season of your life.

It could represent, a promise of God that you desire to see fulfilled for yourself personally, for your family, for your children, or in some other area of life.

"your mountain" is God's promise to you that He wants you to have.

In 2022 – Go take your mountain!

Things may have been delayed, but this year, go in and take your mountain.

There may be giants, but this year you can conquer your giants and take your mountain. Things may have been withheld from you so long, but this year you can occupy your inheritance.

We know what happened 40 years before when Moses sent the 12 spies to search the land for 40 days and come back with their report (Numbers chapters 13 & 14).

In this passage Joshua 14:6-15 we see seven actions steps that Caleb took, which we can follow:



#1, KNOW THE WORD (Joshua 14:6,12)You know the word which the Lord said

#2, SPEAK YOUR FAITH (Joshua 14:7) I spoke what was in my heart

#3, RISE ABOVE UNBELIEF (Joshua 14:8) the brethren made the heart of the people become discouraged

#4, WHOLLY FOLLOW GOD (Joshua 14:8) I wholly followed the Lord

#5, KEEP YOURSELF STRONG (Joshua 14:11) I am as strong today, as I was then

#6, CONQUER YOUR GIANTS! (Joshua 14:12) I shall be able to drive them out

#7, OCCUPY YOUR INHERITANCE! (Joshua 14:13)

The mountain is yours, go take it! Joshua 15:13-15 records that Caleb drove out the giants and occupied Hebron (also known as Kirjath Arba meaning city of Arba or the city of the giants. Hebron means community, alliance, association, friendship)

SUMMARY

Let's review the seven action steps that Caleb took. Think about how you can apply this into your life - to go take your mountain, to conquer your giants, to occupy your inheritance, in this season of your life.

SALVATION CALL

If you ask, does God love me? We can tell you what the Bible says: John 3:16, Romans 5:8

If you ask, how can I have my sins forgiven? We can tell you what the Bible says: Acts 10:43; 1 John 2:2,12

If you ask, what is the way to God? We can tell you what the Bible says: John 14:6 If you ask, how can I become a child of God? We can tell you what the Bible says: John 1:12

If you ask, where can I find salvation? We can tell you what the Bible says: Acts 4:12 If you ask, what must I do to experience salvation? We can tell you what the Bible says: Acts 16:30-31

As an act of your own free choice, we invite you to make this decision to follow Jesus.

The is a simple guide for use in Life Group discussions. Our objective is to focus on the application of the Sunday sermon - how each one is becoming a doer of the Word and building their life on God's Holy Word. Preparation

All these are available in the "All Peoples Church Bangalore" mobile App or online at our sermons page. Pray for the Life Group meeting and invite the work and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Welcome

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

LISTEN to God's Word

Take turns to read the following Scripture references: Joshua 14:6-15; Numbers 13; Numbers 14:1-11

INVESTIGATE God's Word Together

Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.

1, Review the record of the 12 spies who went to spy out the land of Canaan and what happened to the people, on hearing their report.

2, What is the 'mountain' (or mountains) you feel God wants you to 'go take' in this season of your life? What are the giants that seem to stand in your way?

3, Review the seven action steps outlined from Joshua 14, and how you can apply these into your own life to 'Go take your mountain!'.

If time permits, each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key learning and how they see themselves applying it into their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

1, families to be protected and strengthened

2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.

3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project - for God's hand to guide us through the land search and acquisition process, and for finances to be more than enough to get this project done.
