# Healing Belongs To Us Supernatural Sunday Healing Service Sunday February 26, 2023

We will spend some time being reminded from God's Word on God's provision of divine healing for all of us, His children, and then we will pray and expect the Lord to heal, deliver and work miracles amongst us.

As God's children there are several reasons why we can be clear and firm in our conviction that healing belongs to us. As we present these truths from God's Word may faith arise in our hearts.

We know that faith is the substance (confidence) of things hoped for, the evidence (conviction) of things not seen according to Hebrews 11:1, and that faith comes by the hearing of God's Word (Romans 10:17). As we hear the Word of God being preached, let faith arise in our hearts.

Perhaps there are some here who are in need of healing and deliverance in their body or mind. Expect God to fulfill His Word for you today.

## **#1, THE FATHER OF ALL MERCIES**

God is a good, compassionate, and merciful God. His mercies are toward all.

#### Psalm 145:8-9

8 The LORD is gracious and full of compassion, Slow to anger and great in mercy. 9 The LORD is good to all, And His tender mercies are over all His works.

Healing and deliverance are a work of God's goodness, compassion, and mercy. The Lord Jesus healed many as He was moved with compassion for them. People in Bible times cried out for the mercy of God, and Jesus healed them.

## Matthew 14:14

And when Jesus went out He saw a great multitude; and He was moved with compassion for them, and healed their sick.

The leper Mark 1:41

Then Jesus, moved with compassion, stretched out His hand and touched him, and said to him, "I am willing; be cleansed."

Two blind men

Matthew 20:30,34

30 And behold, two blind men sitting by the road, when they heard that Jesus was passing by, cried out, saying, "Have mercy on us, O Lord, Son of David!"

34 So Jesus had compassion and touched their eyes. And immediately their eyes received sight, and they followed Him.

## The demon possessed man

Mark 5:15,19

15 Then they came to Jesus, and saw the one who had been demon-possessed and had the legion, sitting and clothed and in his right mind. And they were afraid.

19 However, Jesus did not permit him, but said to him, "Go home to your friends, and tell them what great things the Lord has done for you, and how He has had compassion on you."

## The Widow of Nain and her dead son

Luke 7:13-15

When the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her and said to her, "Do not weep."

14 Then He came and touched the open coffin, and those who carried him stood still. And He said, "Young man, I say to you, arise."

15 So he who was dead sat up and began to speak. And He presented him to his mother.

We see in the Psalms, healing presented as a work of God's goodness and mercy.

## Psalm 6:2

Have mercy on me, O LORD, for I am weak; O LORD, heal me, for my bones are troubled.

## Psalm 107:20-21

20 He sent His word and healed them, And delivered them from their destructions.
21 Oh, that men would give thanks to the LORD for His goodness, And for His wonderful works to the children of men!

## #2, GOD'S COVENANT OF HEALING

Exodus 15:26 "...For I am the LORD who heals you."

#### Exodus 23:25-26

25 "So you shall serve the LORD your God, and He will bless your bread and your water. And I will take sickness away from the midst of you.

26 No one shall suffer miscarriage or be barren in your land; I will fulfill the number of your days.

# **Deuteronomy 7:15**

"And the LORD will take away from you all sickness,..."

People under the Old Covenant considered healing as one of God's benefits for His people.

## Psalm 103:2-3

2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits:

3 Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases,

The Lord Jesus during His earthly ministry was ministering to people under the Old Covenant. He had not yet set the New Covenant in place. That would happen through His death and resurrection. It is interesting to see how the Lord Jesus ministered to people under the Old Covenant.

# Healing and deliverance are the children's bread (Matthew 15:26).

For the woman who had been bent over with a back problem for eighteen years, He set her free from satan's work, because she was a daughter of Abraham.

## Luke 13:16

So ought not this woman, being a daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has bound—think of it—for eighteen years, be loosed from this bond on the Sabbath?"

If healing and deliverance were part of God's covenant benefits and provisions for His people under the Old Covenant, how much more these would be provisions under the New Covenant, which is a better covenant based on better promises (Hebrews 8:6).

# #3, CHRIST'S FINISHED WORK ON THE CROSS

The prophet Isaiah foretold what Christ would do on the cross:

# Isaiah 53:4-5

4 Surely He has borne our griefs And carried our sorrows; Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted.

5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

During His earthly ministry the Lord Jesus healed people on the basis of what He would do for them on the Cross, just as He forgave sins before the Cross, on the basis of what would be accomplished on the Cross. This was a 'down payment' based on the work that would be completed on the Cross.

#### Matthew 8:16-17

16 When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick, 17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "He Himself took our infirmities and bore our sicknesses."

Isaiah pointed ahead to the Cross and said "by His stripes we are healed". Peter pointed back to the Cross and said "by whose stripes you were healed". Looking back at the Cross, Peter writes in the past tense. The work has been done.

## 1 Peter 2:24

who Himself bore our sins in His own body on the tree, that we, having died to sins, might live for righteousness—by whose stripes you were healed.

The Greek word for "healed" is used in the New Testament for both physical healing and spiritual wholeness. Total, complete healing is ours through the stripes of Jesus.

# **#4, OUR REDEMPTION BLESSING**

The Law was given through Moses. It exposed our sin, the control sin had over our lives, and the death that sin worked in us (Romans 7:7,10-11).

As the apostle Paul look back at the Law, he references the curses that came upon anyone who broke even one part of it (Deuteronomy 27:26; Galatians 3:10). He is referring to all the curses that were pronounced on anyone who broke the Law. This is listed for us in Deuteronomy 28:15-68. The apostle Paul then states emphatically that Christ redeemed us from the curse of the law – the law itself and all the curses that came upon those who broke it. Instead, "the blessing of Abraham" has come upon us!

# Galatians 3:10,13-14

10 For as many as are of the works of the law are under the curse; for it is written, "cursed is everyone who does not continue in all things which are written in the book of the law, to do them."

13 Christ has redeemed us from the curse of the law, having become a curse for us (for it is written, "Cursed is everyone who hangs on a tree"),

14 that the blessing of Abraham might come upon the Gentiles in Christ Jesus, that we might receive the promise of the Spirit through faith.

Deuteronomy 28:15-68 (GNB)

Here is a short list of physical and mental conditions listed under the curses. (From the GNB version).

vs 20: disaster, confusion, and trouble

vs 21: disease after disease

vs 22: infectious diseases, with swelling and fever

vs 27: boils, sores, scabs, itch

vs 28: lose your mind, blindness, confusion

vs 34: lose your mind

vs 35: painful sores and boils head to foot

vs 59: incurable diseases and horrible epidemics

vs 60: dreadful diseases from which you cannot recover

vs 61: all kinds of diseases and epidemics that are not mentioned in this book

vs 64: no peace anywhere, anxiety, hopelessness, and despair

vs 66: filled with terror, live in constant fear of death

vs 67: hearts will pound with fear

We are redeemed from all those things mentioned as curses!

We have been bought with a price-spirit, soul and body.

We are God's property. The body is God's property.

## 1 Corinthians 6:13,20

13 Foods for the stomach and the stomach for foods, but God will destroy both it and them. Now the body is not for sexual immorality but for the Lord, and the Lord for the body.

20 For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

The body is not for sin, but for the Lord and the Lord who is our Sanctifier is for the body.



Similarly, the body is not for sickness, but for the Lord, and the Lord, who is our Healer is for the body.

The life of Jesus is manifested in our mortal, physical bodies (2 Corinthians 4:10-11).

#### **Romans 8:11**

But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

# #5, THE CHURCH'S COMMISSION

The Lord Jesus has commissioned the Church to do what He would do, if He were present here today.

## John 14:12-14

12 "Most assuredly, I say to you, he who believes in Me, the works that I do he will do also; and greater works than these he will do, because I go to My Father.

13 And whatever you ask in My name, that I will do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son.

14 If you ask anything in My name, I will do it.

He went to the Father and sent the mighty Holy Spirit. He also left us with His name authorizing us to act on His behalf.

The Church has been authorized and empowered to heal.

Authority in Jesus name.

Anointed by the Holy Spirit.

#### Mark 16:17-18

17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;

18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

## James 5:14-15

14 Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord.

15 And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

## **LISTEN to God's Word**

Read the following Scripture references: Exodus 15:26; Exodus 23:25; Psalm 103:1-3; Isaiah 53:4-5; Mark 16:17-18, James 5:14-15

## **INVESTIGATE God's Word Together**

Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.

- 1, In presenting the truth that healing belongs to us as God's children, we covered five Biblical reasons. HEALING BELONGS TO US, BECAUSE:
- #1, THE FATHER OF ALL MERCIES
- #2, GOD'S COVENANT OF HEALING
- #3, CHRIST'S FINISHED WORK ON THE CROSS



#4, OUR REDEMPTION BLESSING #5, THE CHURCH'S COMMISSION

Review each of these reasons based on the Scriptures that were presented. Pray for one another, with expectation, for physical and emotional healing.

If time permits, each one can take a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key learning and how they see themselves applying it into their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

# FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

# **ENCOURAGE** each other by praying and ministering to one another

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

# Regroup and pray together for:

- 1, families to be protected and strengthened
- 2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.
- 3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project for God's hand to guide us through the land search and acquisition process, and for finances to be more than enough to get this project done.

We highlight: (1) the Father of all mercies (2) God's covenant of healing, (3) Christ's finished work on the Cross, (4) our redemption blessing, (5) the Church's commission. Faith is birthed and nurtured in our hearts as we hear God's Word. God moves in response to our faith, supernaturally by His Spirit.
