



How To Receive Divine Healing (Part-3) Supernatural Sunday July 30, 2023

When it comes to supernatural healing, we must remember that there are many ways through which God administers His healing power.

GOD ADMINISTERS HIS HEALING THROUGH MANY DIFFERENT WAYS

There are many ways we can receive divine healing:

1. Through His Word and personal faith – released through prayer, praise, declaration, and action.
2. Through the quickening of His indwelling Spirit.
3. Through the power of His life in you.
4. Through receiving the prayer of faith in Jesus' name.
5. Through the prayer of agreement in faith.
6. Through the healing anointing (laying on of hands, prayer cloths, touch).
7. Through a word of command spoken over you in faith.
8. Through partaking in the Lord's Table in faith.
9. Through the ministry of deliverance.
10. Through the manifestation of the gifts of the Spirit, (word of knowledge, gifts of healings, and working of miracles).
11. Through the manifestation of His healing presence.
12. Through the sovereign work of His glory.
13. Through releasing forgiveness to others.
14. Through receiving emotional healing and inner wholeness.
15. Through renouncing and breaking of generational curses.

We've have mentioned several ways we see God administer healing. There are other ways as well. Often, we will see God work in a combination of these ways.

In the recent Supernatural Sundays, we looked at several ways through which we can receive divine healing:

Through His Word and personal faith – released through prayer, praise, declaration, and action.

Through the quickening of His indwelling Spirit.

Through the power of His life in you.

Through receiving the prayer of faith in Jesus' name.

Through the prayer of agreement in faith.

Through the healing anointing (laying on of hands, prayer cloths, touch).

THROUGH A WORD OF COMMAND SPOKEN OVER YOU IN FAITH.

In many of the healing miracles of Jesus, recorded for us in the Gospel's we see that the Lord Jesus spoke words to the sick person to minister healing:

Pastors, you can mention a few from the list below....no need to mention all of them...no need to describe the situation in detail...

The leper (Matthew 8:2-4; Mark 1:40-42; Luke 5:12-14)
The centurion's servant (Matthew 8:5-13; Luke 7:1-10)
Peter's wife's mother (Luke 4:38-39)
The paralyzed man carried by four friends (Matthew 9:2-8; Mark 2:3-12; Luke 5:17-26)
The woman with the issue of blood (Matthew 9:20-22; Mark 5:24-34; Luke 8:42-48)
Two blind men (Matthew 9:27-31)
The man with the withered hand (Matthew 12:9-14; Mark 3:1-6; Luke 6:6-11)
The deaf and dumb man (Mark 7:31-37)
The blind man of Bethsaida (Mark 8:22-26)
Blind Bartimaeus (Matthew 20:29-34; Mark 10:46-52; Luke 18:35-43)
The ten lepers (Luke 17:11-19)
The noble man's son (John 4:46-53)
The man at the pool of Bethesda (John 5:1-9)
The man born blind (John 9:1-7)

Even when Jesus raised the dead, we see Him speaking a word of command:
Jairus' daughter (Matthew 9:18; Mark 5:22; Luke 8:40)
Widow's son (Luke 7:11-17)
Lazarus (John 11:1-44)

In the Book of Acts, we see the Early Church minister in a similar manner:
Lame man at the Temple gate (Acts 3:1-16)
Ananias ministering healing to Saul who was blinded (Acts 9:17)
Peter administering healing to the lame man, Aneas (Acts 9:32-35)



We minister and receive healing this same way today. We speak in the authority of Jesus' name commanding sickness to leave, commanding wholeness to come.
We receive in faith.
We act in faith.
God does the work of healing and wholeness.

THROUGH PARTAKING IN THE LORD'S TABLE IN FAITH.

In Scripture we see several "types and shadows". These refer to actual incidents in the Old Testament that point to a reality experienced in the New Testament.

One of these "types and shadows" is that of the Passover lamb. On the night of their deliverance from Egyptian slavery, every Hebrew home, killed a lamb. They applied the blood of the Passover lamb to the door posts of their home, and they ate the meat of the lamb.

Exodus 12:7-8

7 And they shall take some of the blood and put it on the two doorposts and on the lintel of the houses where they eat it.

8 Then they shall eat the flesh on that night; roasted in fire, with unleavened bread and with bitter herbs they shall eat it.

That night they experienced a great deliverance, miraculous transfer of wealth from the Egyptians into their hands.

The Scriptures record that they came out whole and healthy as a nation, with not even one sickly person.

Psalm 105:37

He also brought them out with silver and gold, And there was none feeble (*sickly*) among His tribes.

God supernaturally took care of them for forty years.

Nehemiah 9:21

Forty years You sustained them in the wilderness; They lacked nothing; Their clothes did not wear out And their feet did not swell.

The Old Testament was a type and shadow - pointing ahead to the reality in Jesus Christ the True Passover Lamb.



1 Corinthians 5:7

Therefore purge out the old leaven, that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.

If the “type and shadow”, which are only pointers to the reality, could bring such great blessing, how much more, will us having the reality – Christ the true Passover Lamb, enable us to walk in much more blessing.

In the Old Testament, they “applied” the blood and “ate” the flesh. In the New Testament as we “drink the cup” and “eat the bread” we are partaking, that is receiving, the blessing provided for us through Christ our Passover Lamb.

1 Corinthians 10:16

The cup of blessing which we bless, is it not the communion of the blood of Christ? The bread which we break, is it not the communion of the body of Christ?

THROUGH THE MINISTRY OF DELIVERANCE.

Some sicknesses are caused due to the direct presence and work of evil spirits.

We see a few examples in the ministry of Jesus, where when evil spirits were cast out healing took place.

Matthew 8:16

When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick,

Matthew 9:32-33

**32 As they went out, behold, they brought to Him a man, mute and demon-possessed.
33 And when the demon was cast out, the mute spoke. And the multitudes marveled, saying, "It was never seen like this in Israel!"**

In a similar way, today we cast out spirits of infirmity, spirits causing sickness and disease, and experience supernatural healing.
