

# How To Receive Divine Healing (Part-4) Supernatural Sunday August 27, 2023

In the recent Supernatural Sundays, we looked at several ways through which we can receive divine healing.

When it comes to supernatural healing, we must remember that there are many ways through which God administers His healing power.

We've have mentioned several ways we see God administer healing. There are other ways as well. Often, we will see God work in a combination of these ways.

GOD ADMINISTERS HIS HEALING THROUGH MANY DIFFERENT WAYS

There are many ways we can receive divine healing:

- 1. Through His Word and personal faith released through prayer, praise, declaration, and action.
- 2. Through the quickening of His indwelling Spirit.
- 3. Through the power of His life in you.
- 4. Through receiving the prayer of faith in Jesus' name.
- 5. Through the prayer of agreement in faith.
- 6. Through the healing anointing (laying on of hands, prayer cloths, touch).
- 7. Through a word of command spoken over you in faith.
- 8. Through partaking in the Lord's Table in faith.
- 9. Through the ministry of deliverance.
- 10. Through the manifestation of the gifts of the Spirit, (word of knowledge, gifts of healings, and working of miracles).
- 11. Through the manifestation of His healing presence.
- 12. Through the sovereign work of His glory.
- 13. Through releasing forgiveness to others.
- 14. Through receiving emotional healing and inner wholeness.
- 15. Through renouncing and breaking of generational curses.

## TODAY

We will consider three of these:

Through the manifestation of the gifts of the Spirit, (word of knowledge, gifts of healings, and working of miracles).

## THROUGH THE MANIFESTATION OF THE GIFTS OF THE SPIRIT

word of knowledge, gifts of healings, and working of miracles).

1 Corinthians 12:4-11

4 There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit.

5 There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord.

6 And there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all.

7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all:

8 for to one is given the word of wisdom through the Spirit, to another the word of knowledge through the same Spirit,

9 to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healings by the same Spirit, 10 to another the working of miracles, to another prophecy, to another discerning of spirits, to another different kinds of tongues, to another the interpretation of tongues.

11 But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills.

God has placed these gifts in the body because He wants to bless His people and minister to their needs.

These are gifts of grace, "charismata", which means that they are given freely by grace. We do not work or earn these.

These gifts of the Spirit are released through people, believers, to bless other people, saved and unsaved. These serve to bless people, meet their needs, and also to let them know and encounter God in a real, personal way.

There are three gifts we see often working towards getting people healed and delivered.

Word of knowledge Gifts of healings Working of miracles

## THROUGH THE MANIFESTATION OF HIS HEALING PRESENCE.



Often, while being in God's presence healings, deliverance and miracles will take place. We must expect this to happen, any where (in our homes, life groups, services, etc.).

Consider a few Scriptures.

#### Habakkuk 3:3-4

3 God came from Teman, The Holy One from Mount Paran. Selah. His glory covered the heavens, And the earth was full of His praise.

4 <mark>His brightness</mark> was like the light; He had rays flashing from <mark>His hand</mark>, And there <mark>His</mark> <mark>power</mark> was hidden.

God came....God moving into a place.

There was praise. It is people who praise Him. When we praise God, it creates a place that God enters into.

When God comes...His glory. His brightness (presence). His hand. His power...are there.

God comes into where His praise is.

When God comes, we can expect His glory, His presence, His hand (working), His power to be manifested.

Notice another Scripture.

#### Malachi 4:2

But to you who fear My name The <mark>Sun</mark> of Righteousness shall arise With healing in His <mark>wings</mark>; And you shall go out And grow fat like stall-fed <mark>calves</mark>.

There are several metaphors being used here – the sun shining, the wings of a bird, well fed calves.

When God rises extending and releasing His presence like the Sun, shining, there is healing that covers us and we are made whole, strong, and full of health like well fed calves.

So in the presence of God we can expect healing, wholeness and strength.

We know that praise and worship is a key to inviting and hosting God's presence amongst us.



Luke 5:17

Now it happened on a certain day, as He was <mark>teaching</mark>, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And the power of the Lord was present to heal them.

We also learn that when Jesus was teaching – ministering the Word – the power of the Lord was present to heal the people. God was present to heal and deliver as the Word was being administered. This is another key to experiencing God's healing presence.

## THROUGH THE SOVEREIGN WORK OF HIS GLORY.

There are times, God moves sovereignly, independently of prayer, expectation, or faith, and works His healing often through His people. We note one example in John 5.

John 5:1-9,19

1 After this there was a feast of the Jews, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem.

2 Now there is in Jerusalem by the Sheep Gate a pool, which is called in Hebrew, Bethesda, having five porches.

3 In these lay a great multitude of sick people, blind, lame, paralyzed, waiting for the moving of the water.

4 For an angel went down at a certain time into the pool and stirred up the water; then whoever stepped in first, after the stirring of the water, was made well of whatever disease he had.

5 Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity thirty-eight years.

6 When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been in that condition a long time, He said to him, "Do you want to be made well?"

7 The sick man answered Him, "Sir, I have no man to put me into the pool when the water is stirred up; but while I am coming, another steps down before me."

8 Jesus said to him, "Rise, take up your bed and walk."

9 And immediately the man was made well, took up his bed, and walked. And that day was the Sabbath.

19 Then Jesus answered and said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, the Son can do nothing of Himself, but what He sees the Father do; for whatever He does, the Son also does in like manner.

It is clear that this man by the pool, who had been sick 38 years, did not know who Jesus was. He was not expecting the Lord Jesus to be heal him. There was no faith in his heart.

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The Lord Jesus was there, a Servant of the Lord. God sovereignly moved through His Servant, and administered healing to a man who was not even expecting this to happen.

The Lord Jesus explained later on (vs 19) that He was instructed by the Father to do this.

God does move sovereignly, independent of the recipient's faith, to release healing. As believers, we must always pray, and be available for God to work through us, following His direction to minister to any one He leads us to, whether or not the person we are ministering to has faith.

#### <u>SUMMARY</u>

Let us expect the blessing of healing, deliverance and miraculous provision and supply in our lives.

As we pray and minister today, we are expecting the Lord to touch people today, just as He did in Bible times. Remember, the power is not in the method that is used, but in the God who heals. The method is just a way for us to express our faith. Our faith is in God, not in the method.

Through the manifestation of the gifts of the Spirit, (word of knowledge, gifts of healings, and working of miracles). Through the manifestation of His healing presence. Through the sovereign work of His glory.

## SERMON OUTLINE

God is Healer of our entire being – spirit, soul, and body. He is Jehovah Rapha. God has established a covenant of healing with us. God has provided healing and wholeness for us through the redemptive work of Christ on the Cross. How do we receive the healing that God has made available to us? There are many ways through which God administers His healing power. There are many ways we can receive divine healing:
