26 He is ever merciful, and lends; And his descendants are blessed.

- 23 They shall not labor in vain, Nor bring forth children for trouble; For they shall be the descendants of the blessed of the LORD, And their offspring with them.

(We taste of the powers of the age to come. Hence we can have a foretaste of what God has in store, here and now. Hebrews 6:5).

Deuteronomy 28:4

"Blessed shall be the fruit of your body,...

Redeemed from the curse

Deuteronomy 28:32,41

- 32 Your sons and your daughters shall be given to another people, and your eyes shall look and fail with longing for them all day long; and there shall be no strength in your hand.
- 41 You shall beget sons and daughters, but they shall not be yours; for they shall go into captivity.

We are redeemed from the curse of the law (Galatians 3:13-14) – the law and the curses that come with it for breaking it. These include children who would be taken away, wander away, go into captivity. What are the things that take children captive today (wrong company, alcohol, drugs, gaming, etc. etc.) We stand against such things and declare that we are redeemed and our children will be free.

Deuteronomy 30:6

And the LORD your God will circumcise your heart and the heart of your descendants, to love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, that you may live.

Malachi 4:5-6

5 Behold, I will send you Elijah the prophet Before the coming of the great and dreadful day of the LORD.



6 And he will turn The hearts of the fathers to the children, And the hearts of the children to their fathers, Lest I come and strike the earth with a curse.

Part of the end-time work of the Holy Spirit, is to turn the heart of the children to the parents and the parents to the children. Let's believe for such a work of the Spirit to take place in our homes and families.

Preparation

All these are available in the "All Peoples Church Bangalore" mobile App or online at our sermons page. Pray for the Life Group meeting and invite the work and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Welcome

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

LISTEN to God's Word

Read the following Scripture references: Review a few of the promises from Psalms, Proverbs and Isaiah. (We cannot review all of them due to lack of time).

INVESTIGATE God's Word Together

Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.

A, Reflect on the Scriptures, encourage one another and pray for each home and family.

If time permits, each one can take a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key learning and how they see themselves applying it into their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

- 1, families to be protected and strengthened
- 2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.
- 3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project for God's hand to guide us through the land search and acquisition process, and for finances to be more than enough to get this project done.
