### TODAY: FAITH IS THE EVIDENCE

Hebrews 11:1 Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:1 (AMPC) Now faith is the assurance (the confirmation, the title deed) of the things [we] hope for, being the proof of things [we] do not see and the conviction of their reality [faith perceiving as real fact what is not revealed to the senses].

In the New Testament, the word faith is a noun, and believe is a verb. Both come from the same root word.

Believing is the act of having faith.

'substance' Greek means support; groundwork; confidence; subsistence; reality; essence.

Used in New Testament times to refer to title deeds.

'evidence' Greek means conviction or proof.

From Hebrews 11:1 we understand the following:

### A) WE MUST HAVE 'THINGS HOPED FOR', TO HAVE FAITH.



Things hope for refer to things you are desiring for, things you are looking forward to, things you are expecting, or anticipating.

What are the things you are hoping for? Don't give up on those things hoped for.

# B) FAITH IS THE SOLID FOUNDATION, THE GROUNDWORK FOR THE THINGS HOPED FOR.

Without this, what is hoped for would just be fantasy. Faith is the solid basis for great expectations.

### C) FAITH GIVES SUBSTANCE OR BRINGS INTO REALITY 'THINGS HOPED FOR'.

## **D) FAITH IS THE TITLE DEED, THE "PROOF OF OWNERSHIP" OF THINGS HOPED FOR.** or things expected (expectations).

Faith in our hearts is the title deed of the things we hope for. Our faith says it is ours, even when our senses cannot recognize it.

# E) FAITH IS THE EVIDENCE, THE CONVICTION, THE "PROOF OF EXISTENCE" OF THINGS NOT SEEN.

Faith is like a 'sixth sense' through which we are convinced of what the five physical senses cannot perceive.

# FAITH'S EVIDENCE AND CONVICTION IS BASED ON WHO GOD IS AND WHAT HE HAS PROMISED.

#### Romans 10:17

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

#### FAITH BELIEVES BEFORE IT SEES!

#### Mark 11:23-24

23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.



Notice what the Lord Jesus taught us when exercising faith. We are to believe (have faith) that we receive them, and then we will have them. We believe first, before something manifests in the natural.

Consider these examples.

#### THE CENTURION

See Matthew 8:5-13

#### Matthew 8:13

Then Jesus said to the centurion, "Go your way; and as you have believed, so let it be done for you." And his servant was healed that same hour.

The Lord Jesus recognized great faith in this Centurion. He had believed – settled the matter in his heart – and so the Lord simply declared it done, just as he had believed.

THE NOBLEMAN

See John 4:46-54

#### John 4:49-50

49 The nobleman said to Him, "Sir, come down before my child dies!" 50 Jesus said to him, "Go your way; your son lives." So the man believed the word that Jesus spoke to him, and he went his way.

The Lord Jesus challenged this man to believe the Word, and this is what he did. He believed the word Jesus spoke and started his journey home. And along the way he received good news of his son's healing.

#### ABRAHAM

#### Romans 4:17-21

17 (as it is written, "I HAVE MADE YOU A FATHER OF MANY NATIONS") in the presence of Him whom he believed—God, who gives life to the dead and calls those things which do not exist as though they did;

18 who, contrary to hope, in hope believed, so that he became the father of many nations, according to what was spoken, "SO SHALL YOUR DESCENDANTS BE."

19 And not being weak in faith, he did not consider his own body, already dead (since he was about a hundred years old), and the deadness of Sarah's womb.

20 He did not waver at the promise of God through unbelief, but was strengthened in faith, giving glory to God,



### 21 and being fully convinced that what He had promised He was also able to perform.

A powerful passage that teaches us about Abraham's faith. Against all hope he still believed and saw the fruit of believing God.
