**Jesus is Here! He Makes Whole!**  
**Supernatural Sunday May 26, 2024**

The Jesus of the Bible is the Jesus of today.  
He is the same yesterday, today and forever.  
He saves, heals, delivers, works miracles, transforms lives and makes us whole.

Today, we focus on the wholeness He brings to our lives.

Wholeness includes healing of the total person - spirit, soul and body.

### **JESUS HEALS THE BROKEN HEARTED**

#### **Luke 4:18-19**

**18 the Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because He has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to proclaim liberty to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to set at liberty those who are oppressed; 19 to proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.**

Think about some of these people who encountered Jesus during His earthly ministry. The wholeness that Jesus brought into their lives.

The lepers who were cleansed – healed and accepted in society.

The woman with the issue of blood – healed and free to be among people.

The Samaritan woman who went from husband to husband seeking for love she could never find – found life giving water that quenched her thirst forever.

The woman caught in adultery who felt ashamed, condemned, and rejected – was forgiven and accepted.

### **JESUS DIED TO MAKE US WHOLE**

#### **Isaiah 53:5**

**But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace (shalom =wholeness) was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.**

He paid the price not only for the forgiveness of our sins, and healing of our sicknesses, but also to bring us shalom, to make us whole.

### **JESUS IS LORD OVER DEATH**

He raised the dead.

Jairus' daughter (Matthew 9:18; Mark 5:22; Luke 8:40)

Widow's son (Luke 7:11-17)

Lazarus (John 11:1-44)

He conquered death, hell, and the grave.

He still gives life to the dead.

He still resurrects broken lives, wounded lives, shattered dreams, and the dead.

And one day He is coming back to receive us to Himself and give us resurrected, glorified, perfectly whole bodies and minds.

Today, as the Resurrection and the Life, He brings to us a foretaste of things to come. He brings to us the wholeness that we one day will have in full measure.

**Jesus is Here! He Makes Whole!**  
**Supernatural Sunday May 26, 2024**

This is a simple guide for use in Life Group discussions. Our objective is to focus on the application of the Sunday sermon - how each one is becoming a doer of the Word and building their life on God's Holy Word. The Life Group meeting would normally last for 2 hours. Each Life Group would have up to 12-15 people.

**Preparation**

To prepare for the Life Group meeting, you can listen to the Sermon Key Points (sermon summary in five minutes) or the full-length Sunday sermon. You can also review the Sunday Sermon notes. All these are available in the "All Peoples Church Bangalore" mobile App or online at our [sermons page](#). Pray for the Life Group meeting and invite the work and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

**Welcome**

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

**LISTEN to God's Word**

Read the following Scripture references: *Luke 4:18-19; Isaiah 53:5*

**INVESTIGATE God's Word Together**

Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.

- 1, Discuss what it means to whole – well in spirit, soul and body – spiritually, emotionally and physically well.*
- 2, Discuss “shalom” which represents wholeness, a state of complete well-being. Discuss the provision Jesus made for our shalom, as stated in Isaiah 53:5*
- 3, Pray for the blessing of shalom, for each other.*



If time permits, each one can take a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key learning and how they see themselves applying it into their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

**FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey**

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

**ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another**

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

- 1, families to be protected and strengthened*
- 2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.*
- 3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project - for all details to go well as we plan and build our Bible college and church facilities to serve the Lord and people.*
