Jesus is Risen – He Still Heals and Delivers April 27, 2025 - Sermon Outline Supernatural Sunday

The Early Church proclaimed a resurrected Jesus – and declared Him to be the same miracle working Jesus. He didn't stop being the healing, delivering Jesus after His resurrection.

THE SAME MIRACLE WORKING JESUS HAS BEEN RAISED UP

Acts 2:22-24

22 "Men of Israel, hear these words: Jesus of Nazareth, a Man attested by God to you by miracles, wonders, and signs which God did through Him in your midst, as you yourselves also know—

23 Him, being delivered by the determined purpose and foreknowledge of God, you have taken by lawless hands, have crucified, and put to death;

24 whom God raised up, having loosed the pains of death, because it was not possible that He should be held by it.

32 This Jesus God has raised up, of which we are all witnesses.

The outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Day of Pentecost was evidence to the resurrection.

HE IS EXALTED AS LORD AND CHRIST

Acts 2:33,36

33 Therefore being exalted to the right hand of God, and having received from the Father the promise of the Holy Spirit, He poured out this which you now see and hear.

36 Therefore let all the house of Israel know assuredly that God has made this Jesus, whom you crucified, both Lord and Christ.

The resurrected Christ is exalted as Lord (ruler, sovereign) and Christ (the Anointed One, the Messiah, the Savior, Redeemer).



THE HEALING OF THE LAME MAN

The healing of the lame man was an attestation that God had raised him from the dead.

Acts 3:14-16

14 But you denied the Holy One and the Just, and asked for a murderer to be granted to you,

15 and killed the Prince of life, whom God raised from the dead, of which we are witnesses.

16 And His name, through faith in His name, has made this man strong, whom you see and know. Yes, the faith which comes through Him has given him this perfect soundness in the presence of you all.

Acts 4:10

let it be known to you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom you crucified, whom God raised from the dead, by Him this man stands here before you whole.

A LIVING JESUS ANSWERS PRAYERS AND WORKS SIGNS AND WONDERS

As the early church faced persecution and threats, they asked for more demonstration of signs and wonders in the name of the resurrected Christ.

Acts 4:29-31

29 Now, Lord, look on their threats, and grant to Your servants that with all boldness they may speak Your word,

30 by stretching out Your hand to heal, and that signs and wonders may be done through the name of Your holy Servant Jesus."

31 And when they had prayed, the place where they were assembled together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

SIGNS, WONDERS, MIRACLES, GIFTS OF THE HOLY SPIRIT - ATTEST TO THE RESURRECTION

This became the primary way the Early Church attested to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus.

Acts 4:33

And with great power the apostles gave witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus. And great grace was upon them all.

The preaching of the Gospel message continued to be accompanied by signs, wonders, miracles, gifts of the Holy Spirit.

Hebrews 2:3-4

3 how shall we escape if we neglect so great a salvation, which at the first began to be spoken by the Lord, and was confirmed to us by those who heard Him,

4 God also bearing witness both with signs and wonders, with various miracles, and gifts of the Holy Spirit, according to His own will?

Hebrews 13:8

Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

The Jesus of the Bible is the Jesus of today!

The resurrected Jesus is still the same miracle working, healing, delivering Jesus as He revealed Himself during His earthly ministry.

This is a simple guide for use in Life Group discussions. Our objective is to focus on the application of the Sunday sermon - how each one is becoming a doer of the Word and building their life on God's Holy Word. The Life Group meeting would normally last for 1.5 to 2 hours. Each Life Group would have up to 12-15 people.

Preparation

Life Group Leader: To prepare for the Life Group meeting, you can listen to the Sermon or review the Sunday Sermon notes. Please do not make your life group read through the complete sermon notes during the life group. All you need to do is have individuals read the Scriptures listed below and then open for a time of discussion, sharing and learning using the questions given below. All these are available in the "All Peoples Church Bangalore" mobile App or online at our [sermons page](#). Pray for the Life Group meeting and invite the work and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Welcome

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

LISTEN to God's Word

Read the following Scripture references: *Acts 2:22-24,33,36; Acts 3:14-16; Acts 4:10,29-31,33; Hebrews 2:3-4; 13:8*

INVESTIGATE God's Word Together

Life Group is a discussion-based, participatory meeting with everyone given the opportunity to share their learning. Please discuss a few of these

together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.

1, Discuss for and against the statement: "The resurrected Jesus is still the same miracle working, healing, delivering Jesus as He revealed Himself during His earthly ministry." Why can we believe this statement to be true? Why would some consider not to believe this even though they believe in the resurrection of Christ?

Each one can take a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key insights and how they see themselves applying it to their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow, bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

- 1, families to be protected and strengthened*
- 2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.*
- 3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project - for all details to go well as we plan and build our Bible college and church facilities to serve the Lord and people.*
