We emphasized last week that: **TO BE PROPHETIC IS TO KNOW AND UNDERSTAND THE MIND OF THE LORD, HIS WAYS AND THOUGHTS, SO THAT WE CAN THINK, ACT AND SPEAK ALIGNED TO HIM, ALL THE TIME.**

**Today: The Spirit of Wisdom**

The prophetic is really an expression of the mind of the Lord (His thoughts and His ways), the wisdom of God, the revelation that comes from Him, the voice of the Lord and the power of the Lord into everyday life. All the gifts of the Spirit work and flow together in the expression of the prophetic.

Last week we focused on one aspect, that of knowing the mind of the Lord. Today, we focus on the Spirit of wisdom, to understand how we need to receive and yield to Him, as prophetic people.

**The prophetic is brining expressions of the Spirit of wisdom in everyday life, in our homes, families, workplace, communities, nations, in all spheres so that the glory of God is revealed and His Kingdom is advanced here on earth.**

The Holy Spirit is referred to as the Spirit of wisdom.



### Isaiah 11:2

**The Spirit of the LORD shall rest upon Him, The Spirit of wisdom and understanding, The Spirit of counsel and might, The Spirit of knowledge and of the fear of the LORD.**

We will consider several passages from the Old Testament to see how the Spirit of wisdom is released and expressed in daily life – so that we can expect and work together with Him.

### Exodus 28:3-8 (capitalization added)

**3 So you shall speak to all who are GIFTED artisans, whom I have filled with the SPIRIT OF WISDOM, that they may make Aaron's garments, to consecrate him, that he may minister to Me as priest.**

**4 And these are the garments which they shall make: a breastplate, an ephod, a robe, a SKILLFULLY woven tunic, a turban, and a sash. So they shall make holy garments for Aaron your brother and his sons, that he may minister to Me as priest.**

**5 "They shall take the gold, blue, purple, and scarlet thread, and the fine linen,**

**6 and they shall make the ephod of gold, blue, purple, and scarlet thread, and fine woven linen, ARTISTICALLY worked.**

**7 It shall have two shoulder straps joined at its two edges, and so it shall be joined together.**

**8 And the INTRICATELY woven band of the ephod, which is on it, shall be of the same workmanship, made of gold, blue, purple, and scarlet thread, and fine woven linen.**

God commissioned Moses to build the Tabernacle. To accomplish this work, God anointed certain people with the Spirit of wisdom. Consider what the Spirit of wisdom imparted to them and how He expressed Himself through them. The Spirit of wisdom made these people gifted, skillful, artistic (creative) and ingenious (the word 'intricately' means ingeniously – innovatively, very cleverly, etc.).

We are not speaking about natural talent – but what is imparted by the Spirit of wisdom and becomes a grace that rests and operates in our lives.

### Insight 1:

**Prophetic expressions of the Spirit of wisdom make us gifted (vs 3), skillful (vs 4), creative (vs 6) and ingenious (vs 8).**

### Exodus 31:3-4,6

**3 And I have filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom, in understanding, in knowledge, and in all manner of workmanship,**



**4 to design** artistic works, to work in gold, in silver, in bronze,  
**6 "And I, indeed I, have appointed with him Aholiab the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan; and I have put wisdom in the hearts of all the gifted artisans, that they may make all that I have commanded you:**

We also see that these men were anointed with the Spirit of wisdom for this very purpose – to design, to make – what God desired to be done.

God anoints us with the Spirit of wisdom to carry out Kingdom purposes!

**Insight 2:**

**Prophetic expressions of the Spirit of wisdom enable us to carry out Kingdom purposes.**

After God has spoken to Moses about the task of building the Tabernacle, Moses got all the people together and announced to them about this huge assignment. He invited people to willingly give the required materials and to be involved in the work. Consider what happened:

**Exodus 35:10,20,21,26**

**10 'All who are gifted artisans among you shall come and make all that the LORD has commanded:**

**20 And all the congregation of the children of Israel departed from the presence of Moses.**

**21 Then everyone came whose heart was stirred, and everyone whose spirit was willing, and they brought the LORD's offering for the work of the tabernacle of meeting, for all its service, and for the holy garments.**

**26 And all the women whose hearts stirred with wisdom spun yarn of goats' hair.**

After they heard Moses speak to them, the people went away perhaps to think, pray, consider how they could be involved (vs 20). Then many came with the offerings they wanted to contribute (vs 21). And there were other women, who were filled with wisdom who did work (vs 26).

We learn something here. Wisdom does not mean we don't have to work. We are filled with wisdom to put our hands to work and execute what wisdom we have received.

We can just imagine all these people, sitting under tents in the hot middle eastern sun, sweating it out in the heat, working on metal, wood, cloth, goat's hair, etc. etc....and they are all anointed by the Holy Spirit. They are involved in a very prophetic expression



of the Spirit of wisdom – and yet they are all doing hard work! They are carrying out God's purposes on the earth!

Perhaps, one reason we miss out on the genuine prophetic expressions of the Spirit of wisdom is because of our unwillingness to work hard. Why would God give wisdom to those who will do nothing with it?

We learn something here.

**Insight 3:**

**Prophetic expressions of the Spirit of wisdom involves diligent work to execute what God desires to be established.**

**Exodus 35:31,34**

31 and He has filled him with the Spirit of God, in wisdom and understanding, in knowledge and all manner of workmanship,

34 "And He has put in his heart the ability to teach, in him and Aholiab the son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan.

We also notice that the Spirit of wisdom enables us to teach and impart the knowledge and skill we have received to others.

**Insight 4:**

**Prophetic expressions of the Spirit of wisdom empowers us to impart, equip and nurture skills in others.**

Let us consider other examples of expressions of the Spirit of wisdom.

**Deuteronomy 34:9**

Now Joshua the son of Nun was full of the spirit of wisdom, for Moses had laid his hands on him; so the children of Israel heeded him, and did as the LORD had commanded Moses.

Joshua was called to be a leader, after Moses. He had 'big shoes' to step in to and a huge responsibility. He had been trained well. Joshua would have served under Moses for the entire 40 years. We read about Joshua in the very first year in Exodus 17:9 and then he is handed the leadership in Deuteronomy 34:9. If Joshua was around 20–30 years old at the Exodus (old enough to be a military commander), he would have been about 60–70 years old when he took over leadership and would have lead Israel for about 40-50 years, when he died at the age of 110 (Joshua 24:29).



Aside from all the practical learning, it was the presence of the Spirit of wisdom that equipped Joshua for leadership.

**Insight 5:**

**Prophetic expressions of the Spirit of wisdom empowers us for leadership.**

Consider kind David. He was a shepherd. He had not been trained or schooled in any way, concerning designing buildings, architecture, civil engineering, etc. But consider what happened:

**1 Chronicles 28:12,19**

**12 and the plans for all that he had by the Spirit, of the courts of the house of the LORD, of all the chambers all around, of the treasuries of the house of God, and of the treasuries for the dedicated things;**

**19 "All this," said David, "the LORD made me understand in writing, by His hand upon me, all the works of these plans."**

**Insight 6:**

**Prophetic expressions of the Spirit of wisdom empowers us beyond our natural abilities, competencies or skills.**

The LORD made me understand = the Lord gave me insight

In writing = as giving something that is written, clear, precise

By His hand upon me = His moving upon me

One final example we consider is that of Daniel. Daniel, anointed as a prophet of God, expressed God's wisdom to leaders in three empires- the Babylonian, the Medes, and the Persians. These were not God-fearing leaders, and yet, Daniel expressed the wisdom of God, and had their respect.

**Daniel 5:12,14**

**12 Inasmuch as an excellent spirit, knowledge, understanding, interpreting dreams, solving riddles, and explaining enigmas were found in this Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar, now let Daniel be called, and he will give the interpretation."**

**14 I have heard of you, that the Spirit of God is in you, and that light and understanding and excellent wisdom are found in you.**

**Insight 7:**

**Prophetic expressions of the Spirit of wisdom impacts and influences kings, leaders, places of power and seats of authority.**



Let's make these relevant **IN TODAY'S WORLD**

The Holy Spirit moves upon us by His inspiration releasing wisdom to us. As we yield to what He gives to us, we bring forth prophetic expressions of the Spirit of wisdom.

*As we express the Spirit of wisdom, through the prophetic and the inspiration the Spirit of God provides what can we expect?*

#### **Proverbs 8:12-21**

In Proverbs 8, we see how wisdom affects our lives. Through wisdom we can walk in:

- Prudence, knowledge, inventions
- Provide counsel, bring understanding
- Provide leadership (lead, guide, govern, administer, etc.)
- Cause increase in wealth, profitability, etc.
- Righteousness, justice

The Psalmist prayed for God's work, God's glory, God's beauty (grandeur, excellence, greatness) to be released upon us and be expressed through the work of our hands. This is what happens as we allow the Spirit of wisdom, through the flow of the prophetic, to be released through us.

#### **Psalm 90:16-17**

**16 Let Your work appear to Your servants, And Your glory to their children.**

**17 And let the beauty of the LORD our God be upon us, And establish the work of our hands for us; Yes, establish the work of our hands.**

Because of the Spirit of wisdom, we will excel in our work. We will be able to stand before those in places of authority and bring God's voice to them.

#### **Proverbs 22:29**

**Do you see a man who excels in his work? He will stand before kings; He will not stand before unknown men.**

In closing, we remind us about the importance of wisdom itself:

**Ecclesiastes 9:16,18; 10:10**

Wisdom is better than strength

Wisdom is better than weapons of war

Wisdom brings success

**Welcome**

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

**LISTEN to God's Word**

Read the following Scripture references: *Isaiah 11:2; Exodus 28:3-8; Daniel 5:12,14*

**INVESTIGATE God's Word Together**

Life Group is a discussion-based, participatory meeting with everyone given the opportunity to share their learning. Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.

*Reflect on the 7 insights that were presented concerning the Spirit of wisdom. Consider how we receive wisdom through prophetic inspiration and how we can release these in our daily lives.*

**FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey**

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

**ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another**

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow, bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

*1, families to be protected and strengthened*

*2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.*

*3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project - for all details to go well as we plan and build our Bible college and church facilities to serve the Lord and people.*
