

God's Will is to Heal – Divine Healing (Part-1) Sunday November 02, 2025 – Sermon Outline

We begin a series of messages on Divine Healing. This is a subject we are familiar with. Our intent is to help build faith and help us receive healing for body and mind. Come with expectation. Listen with expectation. Let us expect the Lord to heal, deliver and make whole.

Today we wish to emphasize that it is God's will to heal — at all times, from all conditions, always. God is not the author of sickness and disease. He is the Healer, the Great Physician.

Today, we remind ourselves of several reasons, why we state that it is God's will to heal. If we are convinced that is IS God's will to heal us, we can pray, ask and expect with confidence. The Bible teaches us in 1 John 5:14-15, that if we ask according to His will He hears us and we know that we have what we asked of Him.

#1, HIS NATURE

It is God's nature to heal. This is who He is. The Lord our Physician. His nature is revealed through His name and His covenant.

His covenant

Exodus 15:26

and said, "If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the LORD who heals you."

His name

Mark 16:17-18

17 And these signs will follow those who believe: In My name they will cast out demons; they will speak with new tongues;

18 they will take up serpents; and if they drink anything deadly, it will by no means hurt them; they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover.

Jesus taught us to use His name to cast out demons and to heal the sick. This means that it is His will to heal because He authorized us to use His name to heal the sick.

#2, HIS PROMISES

Every promise of God is an expression of the will of God. God would not promise something, that He did not will for us to have.

Exodus 23:25-26

25 "So you shall serve the LORD your God, and He will bless your bread and your water. And I will take sickness away from the midst of you.

26 No one shall suffer miscarriage or be barren in your land; I will fulfill the number of your days.

He promised to remove sickness, to protect us in childbearing and to give us long life.

Psalm 103:1-5

- 1 A Psalm Of David. Bless the LORD, O my soul; And all that is within me, bless His holy name!
- 2 Bless the LORD, O my soul, And forget not all His benefits:
- 3 Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases,
- 4 Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you with lovingkindness and tender mercies,
- 5 Who satisfies your mouth with good things, So that your youth is renewed like the eagle's.

His benefits or blessings include forgiveness of sins and healing from ALL diseases.

Proverbs 3:7-8

7 Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the LORD and depart from evil.

8 It will be health to your flesh, And strength to your bones.

Walking in reverence and obedience to God positions us to receive the blessing of health and strength.

#3, HIS WORKS

God works according to His nature. He works express who He is.

We see the works of God in creation, and in what how He intervenes in our lives. God is impartial and what He does for one He will do for another.

God's design in creation shows that healing is part of what He put in place. Our bodies try to heal naturally.

The world before the Fall was without sickness. The new heavens and new earth, once everything is restored, will be without sickness.

God works by His Word and by His Spirit.

His Word

God works by His Word and the Bible teaches us that His Word brings healing to us.

Psalm 107:20

He sent His word and healed them, And delivered them from their destructions.

Proverbs 4:20-22

- 20 My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings.
- 21 Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart;
- 22 For they are life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh.

His Spirit

God works by His Spirit and one aspect of the work of the Spirit is to heal and deliver.

Acts 10:38

how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and with power, who went about doing good and healing all who were oppressed by the devil, for God was with Him.

Romans 8:11

But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

#4, HIS SON

The Lord Jesus Christ reveals God to us, perfectly. Jesus is the image of the invisible God. He is the exact representation of the Father.



We never see Jesus teach that sickness was some work of God. We never see Jesus tell anyone that God did not want to heal them or that it was God's will for them to remain sick.

Jesus healed all who came to Him in faith.

Matthew 12:15

But when Jesus knew it, He withdrew from there. And great multitudes followed Him, and He healed them all.

Luke 6:19

And the whole multitude sought to touch Him, for power went out from Him and healed them all.

Jesus healed them all – and this is the Father's will, to heal all. He still wills to heal all.

#5, HIS PROVISION OF REDEMPTION

The Cross is for everybody. What Jesus did on the Cross, He did for every person.

The Bible is very clear that physical healing and wholeness was provided for us through the Cross.

Isaiah 53:4-5

4 Surely He has borne our griefs (sickness) And carried our sorrows (pains); Yet we esteemed Him stricken, Smitten by God, and afflicted.

5 But He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities; The chastisement for our peace (wholeness) was upon Him, And by His stripes we are healed.

Matthew 8:16-17

16 When evening had come, they brought to Him many who were demon-possessed. And He cast out the spirits with a word, and healed all who were sick,

17 that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by Isaiah the prophet, saying: "HE HIMSELF TOOK OUR INFIRMITIES AND BORE OUR SICKNESSES."

The Holy Spirit through the Gospel writer Mathew references Isaiah 53:4-5 and states very clearly that healing and deliverance is available through the Cross.

The is a simple guide for use in Life Group discussions. Our objective is to focus on the application of the Sunday sermon - how each one is becoming a doer of the Word and building their life on God's Holy Word. The Life Group meeting would normally last for 1.5 to 2 hours. Each Life Group would have up to 12-15 people.

Preparation

Life Group Leader: To prepare for the Life Group meeting, you can listen to the Sermon or review the Sunday Sermon notes. Please do not make your life group read through the complete sermon notes during the life group. All you need to do is have individuals read the Scriptures listed below and then open for a time of discussion, sharing and learning using the questions given below. All these are available in the "All Peoples Church Bangalore" mobile App or online at our sermons page. Pray for the Life Group meeting and invite the work and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Welcome

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

LISTEN to God's Word

Read the following Scripture references: Exodus 23:25-26; Proverbs 3:7-8; Psalm 107:20; Proverbs 4:20-22

INVESTIGATE God's Word Together

Life Group is a discussion-based, participatory meeting with everyone given the opportunity to share their learning. Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.

Q1, Review the five reasons that were presented, based on which we can be absolutely certain that it is God's will to heal all, every time, and from any sickness:

#1, HIS NATURE

#2, HIS PROMISES

#3, HIS WORKS – AS EXPRESSED THROUGH HIS WORD AND HIS SPIRIT

#4, HIS SON

#5, HIS PROVISION OF REDEMPTION

Q2, Discuss: Since we know it is God's will to heal, then these statements are true: (A)We do not need to pray "if it be thy will" (B)We can pray with full faith and confidence that we are asking according to His will (C)Just as we invite anyone to come to Jesus to be forgiven, we can also invite anyone to come to Jesus to be healed because both forgiveness and healing we provided through His death on the Cross, and the Cross is for everyone.

Each one can take a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key insights and how they see themselves applying it to their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow, bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

- 1, families to be protected and strengthened
- 2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.
- 3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project for all details to go well as we plan and build our Bible college and church facilities to serve the Lord and people.
