

God's Healing Word – Divine Healing (Part-3) Sunday November 16, 2025 – Sermon Outline

In this sermon we explore the healing power of God resident in His Word. God's Word is medicine to our whole being spirit, soul and body. We consider practical ways to receive God's Word, mix faith with it, and experience its healing power in body and soul.

God reveals to us in the Scriptures, that His Word is healing to our bodies and minds:

Proverbs 4:20-22

20 My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings.
21 Do not let them depart from your eyes; Keep them in the midst of your heart;
22 For they are life to those who find them, And health to all their flesh.

'health' in Hebrew 'marpe' = cure, medicine, deliverance, remedy, wholeness, soundness

God's Word is life and medicine. So, God instructs us to keep His Word in us, in our hearts, in our ears, and before our eyes so we can receive the life and healing that comes from His Word.

Psalm 107:20

He sent His word and healed them, And delivered them from their destructions.

'healed' in Hebrew 'rapha' = to heal, to cure, what a physician would do 'delivered' in Hebrew 'malat' = release, rescue, bring forth, bring out

God's Word heals and delivers. God heals and delivers us through His Word.

Psalm 119:49-50

49 Remember the word to Your servant, Upon which You have caused me to hope. 50 This is my comfort in my affliction, For Your word has given me life.



"given me life = quickened me, healed me. The Hebrew word 'chayah' means to live, have life, remain alive, sustain life, live prosperously, live forever, be quickened, be alive, be restored to life or health

Hebrews 4:12

For the word of God is living and powerful, and sharper than any two-edged sword, piercing even to the division of soul and spirit, and of joints and marrow, and is a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

God's Word is alive – it is active and it works.

God's Word is powerful – it releases the power of God into our lives.

IN JESUS' MINISTRY

Consider the ministry of Jesus and the emphasis and time He gave to the preaching and teaching of the Word.

Matthew 9:35

Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

Jesus spent much time teaching and preaching. He preached the Gospel and this was accompanied with the healing and delivering of people. We are proclaiming the same Gospel today, and the Gospel has not lost any of its power. The Gospel of the Kingdom is still God's power for salvation to everyone. The Gospel still has the power to transform, heal and deliver.

Luke 5:15 (also Luke 6:19)

However, the report went around concerning Him all the more; and great multitudes came together to hear, and to be healed by Him of their infirmities.

People came to hear and to he healed. This means they listened to His teaching and preaching.

Luke 5:17

Now it happened on a certain day, as He was teaching, that there were Pharisees and teachers of the law sitting by, who had come out of every town of Galilee, Judea, and Jerusalem. And the power of the Lord was present to heal them.



Here is a great example recorded for us where we see the teaching of the Word preceding and being a vehicle of the healing power of God.

The Parable of the Sower

The Lord Jesus taught us a Kingdom principle in the parable of the sower. The seed is the Word of God. The seed has to be sown into our hearts, protected, nurtured and then it will bring forth its fruit. God's Word is miracle seed. It needs to get into us, beyond our minds, and into our hearts where it can "germinate", grow and produce.

Let's now outline how we can experience the healing and delivering power of God that is available to us through His Word.

There are numerous, perhaps 100+ verses in the Bible, including recorded instances of people being healed, in the Bible. All these carry healing power and delivering power and can potentially bring healing to us.

What must we do to get the healing and delivering power resident in God's Word into our bodies and minds? Here are three simple instructions we see in God's Word:

#1, BELIEVE THE WORD

One of the important things we have to do is to believe the Word in our hearts.

Hebrews 4:2

For indeed the gospel was preached to us as well as to them; but the word which they heard did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in those who heard it.

When we hear the Word we must mix faith with it, for the Word to produce in us and benefit us.

1 Thessalonians 2:13

For this reason we also thank God without ceasing, because when you received the word of God which you heard from us, you welcomed it not as the word of men, but as it is in truth, the word of God, which also effectively works in you who believe.

God's Word is designed to work effectively – powerfully – putting forth divine power – in us. How we receive the Word and whether we believe the Word, will determine if the Word will work effectively in us.

#2, SPEAK THE WORD



Sermon Notes, Sermon Outline and Small Group Study Guide

Deuteronomy 30:11-20 is an interesting passage. We realize it is in the Old Testament, but we also know that the apostle Paul referenced Deuteronomy 30:11-14 in Romans 10:6-10 and applied it to us as New Testament believers.

Let's look at this passage and draw key insights:

Deuteronomy 30:11-20

- 11 "For this commandment which I command you today is not too mysterious for you, nor is it far off.
- 12 It is not in heaven, that you should say, 'Who will ascend into heaven for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?'
- 13 Nor is it beyond the sea, that you should say, 'Who will go over the sea for us and bring it to us, that we may hear it and do it?'
- 14 But the word is very near you, in your mouth and in your heart, that you may do it.

 15 "See, I have set before you today life and good, death and evil,
- 16 in that I command you today to love the LORD your God, to walk in His ways, and to keep His commandments, His statutes, and His judgments, that you may live and multiply; and the LORD your God will bless you in the land which you go to possess.
- 17 But if your heart turns away so that you do not hear, and are drawn away, and worship other gods and serve them,
- 18 I announce to you today that you shall surely perish; you shall not prolong your days in the land which you cross over the Jordan to go in and possess.
- 19 I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, that I have set before you life and death, blessing and cursing; THEREFORE CHOOSE LIFE, that both you and your descendants may live;
- 20 that you may love the LORD your God, that you may obey His voice, and that you may cling to Him, for He is your life and the length of your days; and that you may dwell in the land which the LORD swore to your fathers, to Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, to give them."

In vs 11-14 God instructs His people to keep His Word in their mouth and in their hearts. (The apostle instructs us New Testament believers to do the same in Romans 10:6-10).

In this context, God is letting us know that we have a choice to make. There is life, good, and blessing available to us, and there is death, evil and cursing as well. God's recommendation is for us to "choose life". And God Himself offers to be our life, our good, our blessing and longevity. We can enjoy life, goodness, blessing and longevity that comes from our God.

The key given to us in this context is to keep His Word in our heart and mouth. His Words must become our words – the words we speak.

We know from several other places in Scripture about the power of our words. James 3 teaches us about the effect of our tongue, that is, the effect of the words we speak. Proverbs 18:21 teaches us that death and life are in the power of the tongue.

So, our second key in experiencing the healing and delivering power of God's Word is to speak the Word over our own lives.

#3, USE THE SWORD OF THE SPIRIT

While we know that physical and emotional ailments occur due to a variety of reasons, we are also aware that the Scriptures reveal to us that there are spirits that trouble our minds and bodies. God has given us His Word to counter the fiery darts of the enemy.

Ephesians 6:17

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God;

The sword of the Word of God proceeds out of our mouths, just like we see demonstrated by Jesus in Revelation 19:15.

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The is a simple guide for use in Life Group discussions. Our objective is to focus on the application of the Sunday sermon - how each one is becoming a doer of the Word and building their life on God's Holy Word. Preparation

Life Group Leader: To prepare for the Life Group meeting, you can listen to the Sermon or review the Sunday Sermon notes. Please do not make your life group read through the complete sermon notes during the life group. All you need to do is have individuals read the Scriptures listed below and then open for a time of discussion, sharing and learning using the questions given below. All these are available in the "All Peoples Church Bangalore" mobile App or online at our sermons page. Pray for the Life Group meeting and invite the work and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Welcome

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

LISTEN to God's Word

Read the following Scripture references: *Proverbs 4:20-22, Psalm 107:20, Deuteronomy 30:11-20*

INVESTIGATE God's Word Together

Life Group is a discussion-based, participatory meeting with everyone given the opportunity to share their learning. Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.



- Q1, Reflect on the Scriptures that reveal healing power in the Word. Consider the parable of the sower, and how we apply it in the context of sowing seeds of the Word that produce healing in our lives.
- Q2, Reflect on God's heart revealed in Deuteronomy 30:11-20, and the recommendation He makes to us to "choose life". Is it right for us to state that God intends for us to enjoy life, blessing, goodness and length of days?
- Q3, Reflect on how "speaking the Word" helps in getting the Word into our hearts for us to believe it, and also as a sword against the enemy to counter what the devil does?

Each one can take a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key insights and how they see themselves applying it to their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow, bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

- 1, families to be protected and strengthened
- 2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.
- 3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project for all details to go well as we plan and build our Bible college and church facilities to serve the Lord and people.
