In this sermon we discover the power of the Spirit of life who releases His quickening, His life-giving and healing power into our physical bodies so that the life of Jesus is made manifest in our bodies. We also consider the power of the anointing and the healing and miraculous gifts of the Spirit which remove burdens and destroys yokes setting us free from the oppression of sickness and disease.

THE HOLY SPIRIT IN CREATION

Genesis 1:1-2

1 In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.

2 The earth was without form, and void; and darkness was on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

Job 33:4

The Spirit of God has made me, And the breath of the Almighty gives me life.

God the Holy Spirit created our bodies, minds and every part of our being. So He knows how to fix it and make it well and whole. He can do what man, medicine and science cannot do. He can reach into the depth of our being and heal us completely inside out.

THE SPIRIT OF LIFE

11, Romans 8:2

2 For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus has made me free from the law of sin and death.

11 But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you.

The phrase "law of sin and death" can be understood as the dominion or control of sin and death, as Paul has explained in the earlier chapters Romans 5-7.

Sin is death at work in our spirit and soul. When we tolerate sin, we are tolerating the working of death in our spirit and soul, our inner being. Sickness is death at work in our bodies.

The Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Life – the life-giving Spirit. His life given to our soul – mind, will and emotions, makes us whole emotionally. His life released into our bodies, into every cell of our physical bodies, makes us healed and whole physically.

THE LIFE OF JESUS MANIFESTED IN OUR BODIES

2 Corinthians 4:10-11

10 always carrying about in the body the dying of the Lord Jesus, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our body.

11 For we who live are always delivered to death for Jesus' sake, that the life of Jesus also may be manifested in our mortal flesh.

The apostle Paul faced many hardships physically – beaten, stoned, shipwrecked, etc. as he travelled to places proclaiming Jesus Christ. And in that context, He affirms that while the body was beaten, battered, bruised and going through physical hardship – there is something at work in his physical body...."the life of Jesus"! If Paul enjoyed the life of Jesus touching, healing, strengthening his physical body, we can too. Let's affirm as Paul did "the life of Jesus fills every part of my physical body and is made visible, is manifested in my physical body".

The apostle Paul affirmed the life of Jesus is revealed and expressed through his physical body. In Acts 14:19-20, we have an example where though he was stoned and left for dead, he rose walked back to town and continued travelling the next day. Is this humanly possible? Or, is this one of those instances where Paul's statement of the life of Jesus being made manifest in our mortal body would apply?

NOTE: Once again, we are not encouraging us to be foolish or presumptuous in applying this truth. Some people hear something like this and think they have become invincible and immortal physically. So, they don't take care of their physical bodies with proper food, exercise and rest and then soon run into lots of problems that they created for themselves. Let's apply truth with wisdom.

Let's examine a few ways God's Spirit ministers to us in the area of healing for our bodies and minds.



THE ANOINTING DESTROYS YOKES AND REMOVES BURDENS

Isaiah 10:27

It shall come to pass in that day That his burden will be taken away from your shoulder, And his yoke from your neck, And the yoke will be destroyed because of the anointing oil.

Sickness and disease is a yoke and a burden that the devil puts on minds and bodies. It is not a blessing from God. The yoke is destroyed and burdens are removed by the presence and power of the Holy Spirit, the anointing.

THE HOLY SPIRIT IN THE MINISTRY OF JESUS

Jesus ministered by the anointing Luke 4:17-18, Luke 6:19, Matthew 12:28, Acts 10:38

The Gospels are very clear that the Lord Jesus ministered through the power of the Holy Spirit. Every miracle He did, was a work of the Holy Spirit through Him.

It is very evident from the ministry of Jesus, the sickness and disease are an "oppression" of the devil, not a "blessing" from God. If sickness and disease came from God the Jesus would be resisting and fighting against God the Father, by healing people, whom the Father supposedly "blessed with sickness". And we know, this is not the case.

GIFTS OF HEALINGS AND WORKINGS OF MIRACLES

The New Testament in speaking of the manifestations of the Holy Spirit, mentions "gifts of healings" as one of the gifts of the Spirit in 1 Corinthians 12:7-11.

We also see how the gifts of healings and workings of miracles operated in various ways through the Early church. Peter's shadow in Acts 5:12-14, and Paul praying over handkerchiefs and cloths that brought healing and deliverance to people in Acts 19:11 are some examples where the Holy Spirit works in diverse ways to heal and make whole.

The Holy Spirit still works and manifests Himself in these supernatural ways.

The is a simple guide for use in Life Group discussions. Our objective is to focus on the application of the Sunday sermon - how each one is becoming a doer of the Word and building their life on God's Holy Word. The Life Group meeting would normally last for 1.5 to 2 hours. Each Life Group would have up to 12-15 people.

Preparation

Life Group Leader: To prepare for the Life Group meeting, you can listen to the Sermon or review the Sunday Sermon notes. Please do not make your life group read through the complete sermon notes during the life group. All you need to do is have individuals read the Scriptures listed below and then open for a time of discussion, sharing and learning using the questions given below. All these are available in the "All Peoples Church Bangalore" mobile App or online at our sermons page. Pray for the Life Group meeting and invite the work and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Welcome

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

LISTEN to God's Word

Read the following Scripture references: Job 33:4; Romans 8:2,11; 2 Corinthians 4:10-11

INVESTIGATE God's Word Together

Life Group is a discussion-based, participatory meeting with everyone given the opportunity to share their learning. Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.

Q1, Discuss – since the Spirit of God created us, He is more than able to fix, heal and make us whole.

- Q2, Discuss the Holy Spirit is the Spirit of Life, of the Spirit who brings, imparts and releases life. Consider how His releasing His life into us can affect our souls (mind, will and emotions) and bodies.
- Q3, Discuss the apostle Paul affirmed the life of Jesus is revealed and expressed through his physical body. In Acts 14:19-20, we have an example where though he was stoned and left for dead, he rose walked back to town and continued travelling the next day. Is this humanly possible? Or, is this one of those instances where Paul's statement of the life of Jesus being made manifest in our mortal body would apply?

Each one can take a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key insights and how they see themselves applying it to their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow, bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

- 1, families to be protected and strengthened
- 2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.
- 3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project for all details to go well as we plan and build our Bible college and church facilities to serve the Lord and people.
