FOR THE HOME

Proverbs 3:33

The curse of the LORD is on the house of the wicked, But He blesses the home of the just.

Proverbs 14:11

The house of the wicked will be overthrown, But the tent of the upright will flourish.

Proverbs 15:6

In the house of the righteous there is much treasure, But in the revenue of the wicked is trouble.

Proverbs 17:1

Better is a dry morsel with quietness, Than a house full of feasting with strife.

Proverbs 17:13

Whoever rewards evil for good, Evil will not depart from his house.

Proverbs 24:3

**3 Through wisdom a house is built, And by understanding it is established;
4 By knowledge the rooms are filled With all precious and pleasant riches.**

the "house" is a metaphor and represents more than a building. It includes family and relationships, a life or legacy, a business, ministry, or community, stability, continuity, and impact.

Wisdom builds - provides design, direction, and growth.
Understanding establishes, bringing stability and structure.
Knowledge fills with fruitfulness and blessing.
This is God's order for lasting success.

Proverbs 24:27

Prepare your outside work, Make it fit for yourself in the field; And afterward build your house.

"Outside work / field" referring to farming, livelihood, income, provision.
"Build your house" referring to establishing a household, security, stability, legacy.

Building a house without first ensuring productive land would lead to poverty and failure.

Vision without preparation is foolish, and foundation precedes fulfillment.

The wisdom principle is order and priority. Secure provision first; establish security and stability afterward.

TO THE HUSBAND

Proverbs 5:18

18 Let your fountain be blessed, And rejoice with the wife of your youth.

19 As a loving deer and a graceful doe, Let her breasts satisfy you at all times; And always be enraptured with her love.

Proverbs 18:22

He who finds a wife finds a good thing, And obtains favor from the LORD.

Proverbs 19:14

Houses and riches are an inheritance from fathers, But a prudent wife is from the LORD.

Proverbs 31:10-11,28

10 Who can find a virtuous wife? For her worth is far above rubies.

TO THE WIFE



Proverbs 12:4

An excellent wife is the crown of her husband, But she who causes shame is like rottenness in his bones.

excellent Hebrew Chayil = strength, valor, might, excellence, noble character, worth. This word carries the sense of strength, moral power, capability, and noble character.

The same word is used in

Proverbs 31:10 "Who can find a virtuous wife?"

Descriptions of mighty warriors (Exodus 15:4).

Men of valor and strength (Judges 6:12).

Proverbs 14:1

The wise woman builds her house, But the foolish pulls it down with her hands.

Proverbs 21:9

Better to dwell in a corner of a housetop, Than in a house shared with a contentious woman.

21 Bind them continually upon your heart; Tie them around your neck.
22 When you roam, they will lead you; When you sleep, they will keep you; And when you awake, they will speak with you.
23 For the commandment is a lamp, And the law a light; Reproofs of instruction are the way of life,**

The instructions from parents will lead, keep and counsel you.

There is a simple guide for use in Life Group discussions. Our objective is to focus on the application of the Sunday sermon - how each one is becoming a doer of the Word and building their life on God's Holy Word. The Life Group meeting would normally last for 1.5 to 2 hours. Each Life Group would have up to 12-15 people.

Preparation

Life Group Leader: To prepare for the Life Group meeting, you can listen to the Sermon or review the Sunday Sermon notes. Please do not make your life group read through the complete sermon notes during the life group. All you need to do is have individuals read the Scriptures listed below and then open for a time of discussion, sharing and learning using the questions given below. All these are available in the "All Peoples Church Bangalore" mobile App or online at our [sermons page](#). Pray for the Life Group meeting and invite the work and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Welcome

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

LISTEN to God's Word

Read the following Scripture references: *use the Scripture references in the notes*

INVESTIGATE God's Word Together

Life Group is a discussion-based, participatory meeting with everyone given the opportunity to share their learning. Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.

1, Review the Scripture texts from Proverbs for each of the sections we have listed and discuss practical applications of these texts in daily life, and faith in God:

Each one can take a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key insights and how they see themselves applying it to their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow, bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

- 1, families to be protected and strengthened*
- 2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.*
- 3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project - for all details to go well as we plan and build our Bible college and church facilities to serve the Lord and people.*
