PURITY THROUGH THE FEAR OF THE LORD

Proverbs 8:13

The fear of the LORD is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverse mouth I hate.

Proverbs 14:2

He who walks in his uprightness fears the LORD, But he who is perverse in his ways despises Him.

Proverbs 23:17-18

17 Do not let your heart envy sinners, But be zealous for the fear of the LORD all the day;

18 For surely there is a hereafter, And your hope will not be cut off.

PURITY BY REFUSING ENTICEMENTS

Proverbs 1:10-16

10 My son, if sinners entice you, Do not consent.

11 If they say, "Come with us, Let us lie in wait to shed blood; Let us lurk secretly for the innocent without cause;

12 Let us swallow them alive like Sheol, And whole, like those who go down to the Pit;

13 We shall find all kinds of precious possessions, We shall fill our houses with spoil;

14 Cast in your lot among us, Let us all have one purse"—

15 My son, do not walk in the way with them, Keep your foot from their path;

16 For their feet run to evil, And they make haste to shed blood.

Proverbs 16:29-30

29 A violent man entices his neighbor, And leads him in a way that is not good.



30 He winks his eye to devise perverse things; He purses his lips and brings about evil.

PURITY BY CHOOSING INTEGRITY/RIGHTEOUSNESS

Proverbs 10:9

He who walks with integrity walks securely, But he who perverts his ways will become known.

Proverbs 11:3

The integrity of the upright will guide them, But the perversity of the unfaithful will destroy them.

Proverbs 11:5-6

5 The righteousness of the blameless will direct his way aright, But the wicked will fall by his own wickedness.

6 The righteousness of the upright will deliver them, But the unfaithful will be caught by their lust.

PURITY THROUGH TRUTHFULNESS

Proverbs 4:24-27

24 Put away from you a deceitful mouth, And put perverse lips far from you.

25 Let your eyes look straight ahead, And your eyelids look right before you.

26 Ponder the path of your feet, And let all your ways be established.

27 Do not turn to the right or the left; Remove your foot from evil.

Proverbs 12:22

Lying lips are an abomination to the LORD, But those who deal truthfully are His delight.

PURITY THROUGH FAITHFULNESS

Proverbs 5:1 -5

1 My son, pay attention to my wisdom; Lend your ear to my understanding,



2 That you may preserve discretion, And your lips may keep knowledge.
3 For the lips of an immoral woman drip honey, And her mouth is smoother than oil;
4 But in the end she is bitter as wormwood, Sharp as a two-edged sword.
5 Her feet go down to death, Her steps lay hold of hell.

REWARDS OF PURITY

A, God's shares His heart, His secrets

Proverbs 3:32

For the perverse person is an abomination to the LORD, But His secret counsel is with the upright.

B, Many blessings – provision, blessings, good remembrance, strength, stability, etc.

Proverbs 10:3,6,7,29,30

3 The LORD will **not allow the righteous soul to famish**, But He casts away the desire of the wicked.

6 **Blessings** are on the head of the righteous, But violence covers the mouth of the wicked.

7 The **memory** of the righteous is blessed, But the name of the wicked will rot.

29 The way of the LORD is **strength** for the upright, But destruction will come to the workers of iniquity.

30 The righteous will **never be removed**, But the wicked will not inhabit the earth.

C, Will reap good rewards in due time

Proverbs 11:18

The wicked man does deceptive work, But **he who sows righteousness will have a sure reward**.

D, Answered prayer

Proverbs 15:29

The LORD is far from the wicked, But He hears the prayer of the righteous.

E, Favor in high places

Proverbs 16:13

Righteous lips are **the delight of kings**, And they love him who speaks what is right.

Proverbs 22:11

He who loves purity of heart And has grace on his lips, **The king will be his friend**.

Preparation

Please do not make your life group read through the complete sermon notes during the life group. All you need to do is have individuals read the Scriptures listed below and then open for a time of discussion, sharing and learning using the questions given below. All these are available in the "All Peoples Church Bangalore" mobile App or online at our [sermons page](#). Pray for the Life Group meeting and invite the work and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Welcome

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

LISTEN to God's Word

Read the following Scripture references: *use the Scripture references in the notes*

INVESTIGATE God's Word Together

Life Group is a discussion-based, participatory meeting with everyone given the opportunity to share their learning. Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.

2, Discuss the rewards of purity. These should motivate us to walk with purity and integrity.

A, God's shares His heart, His secrets

B, Many blessings – provision, blessings, good remembrance, strength, stability, etc.

C, Will reap good rewards in due time

D, Answered prayer

E, Favor in high places

Each one can take a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key insights and how they see themselves applying it to their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow, bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

1, families to be protected and strengthened

2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.

3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project - for all details to go well as we plan and build our Bible college and church facilities to serve the Lord and people.
