The Jesus of the Bible is the Jesus of today!
Because the Bible teaches us that Jesus is the same yesterday, today and forever!

Hebrews 13:8
Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever.

We consider today a few aspects of Jesus' ministry keeping in mind that today, He would minister in the same manner. He indeed desires to minister in the same manner, by the power of the Holy Spirit expressed through His followers (believers).

Matthew 4:23-25

23 And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all kinds of sickness and all kinds of disease among the people.

24 Then His fame went throughout all Syria; and they brought to Him all sick people who were afflicted with various diseases and torments, and those who were demon-possessed, epileptics, and paralytics; and He healed them.

25 Great multitudes followed Him—from Galilee, and from Decapolis, Jerusalem, Judea, and beyond the Jordan.

Matthew 9:35-36

35 Then Jesus went about all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing every sickness and every disease among the people.

36 But when He saw the multitudes, He was moved with compassion for them, because they were weary and scattered, like sheep having no shepherd.

1, THE JESUS OF THE BIBLE PREACHED THE GOOD NEWS OF THE KINGDOM

John the Baptist announced the coming of the Kingdom of God (or the Kingdom of heaven) on earth. The Lord Jesus continued this announcement of the Kingdom and the Scriptures teach us that Jesus went everywhere preaching the Good News of the Kingdom of God (heaven) and teaching truths/mysteries about the Kingdom of God.



i, The Kingdom of God is far superior to the kingdom of darkness. When we come into the Kingdom of God's dear Son, we are free from the powers of darkness. The Kingdom of God comes with power that dispels, dismantles and destroys the kingdom of darkness.

ii, The Kingdom of God is righteousness, peace, joy, life, healing, blessing – an expression of all that God is, because God is King of this Kingdom.

iii, The Kingdom of God is available and accessible to everyone. We can enter the Kingdom of God through repentance and faith in Jesus Christ. This is GOOD NEWS! All of us are welcome into God's Kingdom

iv, The Kingdom of God has truths and principles that are very different from this world. Jesus taught us how to live by the principles of the Kingdom.

v, The Church is authorized to represent the Kingdom of God here on earth. We have been given the keys of the Kingdom of God and can advance against the powers of darkness and the gates of hell cannot stop the advancing Church.

The Jesus of the Bible still welcomes people into His Kingdom – the Kingdom of God.

2, THE JESUS OF THE BIBLE HEALED ALL/EVERY SICKNESS AND DISEASE

They brought people with all kinds of diseases and Jesus healed them. All He required from them, in most cases, was that they have faith.

[Consider few recorded instances of healing in the Gospels]

The Jesus of the Bible still heals every sickness and disease.

3, THE JESUS OF THE BIBLE SET PEOPLE FREE FROM DEMONS

People brought those who were demon possessed and Jesus set them free.

[Consider few recorded instances of deliverance in the Gospels]

The Jesus of the Bible still sets people free from demons.

4, THE JESUS OF THE BIBLE WAS MOVED WITH COMPASSION FOR THE PEOPLE



The Lord Jesus was moved with compassion. He healed and delivered people out of compassion for them. People cried out to Him for His mercy (compassion) and He responded.

The Jesus of the Bible is still moved with compassion for people and extends His mercy to us.

This is a simple guide for use in Life Group discussions. Our objective is to focus on the application of the Sunday sermon - how each one is becoming a doer of the Word and building their life on God's Holy Word. The Life Group meeting would normally last for 1.5 to 2 hours. Each Life Group would have up to 12-15 people.

Preparation

Life Group Leader: To prepare for the Life Group meeting, you can listen to the Sermon or review the Sunday Sermon notes. Please do not make your life group read through the complete sermon notes during the life group. All you need to do is have individuals read the Scriptures listed below and then open for a time of discussion, sharing and learning using the questions given below. All these are available in the "All Peoples Church Bangalore" mobile App or online at our [sermons page](#). Pray for the Life Group meeting and invite the work and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Welcome

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

LISTEN to God's Word

Read the following Scripture references: *Hebrews 13:8; Matthew 4:23-25; Matthew 9:35-36*

INVESTIGATE God's Word Together

Life Group is a discussion-based, participatory meeting with everyone given the opportunity to share their learning. Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.



1, Reflect on the statement “The Jesus of the Bible is the Jesus of today” based on Hebrews 13:8. Do we really believe that the Jesus we have faith in will do the same things He did in Bible times?

- 1, the Jesus of the Bible preached the good news of the Kingdom*
- 2, the Jesus of the Bible healed all/every sickness and disease*
- 3, the Jesus of the Bible set people free from demons*
- 4, the Jesus of the Bible was moved with compassion for the people*

2, How do we truly and accurately represent the Jesus of the Bible to people in our world today – to replace the wrong ideas/misconceptions that they may have about Jesus and the Christian faith?

Each one can take a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key insights and how they see themselves applying it to their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow, bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

- 1, families to be protected and strengthened*
- 2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.*
- 3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project - for all details to go well as we plan and build our Bible college and church facilities to serve the Lord and people.*
