THE LORD JESUS – OUR EXAMPLE, OUR ROLE MODEL

1 Corinthians 15:45-49

45 And so it is written, "The First Man Adam Became A Living Being." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.

46 However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural, and afterward the spiritual.

47 The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from heaven.

48 As was the man of dust, so also are those who are made of dust; and as is the heavenly Man, so also are those who are heavenly.

49 And as we have borne the image of the man of dust, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly Man.

Adam was the first “prototype” human. But he failed and we have borne this image – all of us born in sin. Jesus Christ is the last Adam, the second Man – God’s perfect prototype human, and we are to bear His image, be formed into His likeness. God has ordained that we be conformed to the image of His Son (Romans 8:29).

Hebrews 10:5,7,9

5 Therefore, when He came into the world, He said: "Sacrifice And Offering You Did Not Desire, But A Body You Have Prepared For Me.

7 Then I Said, 'Behold, I Have Come—In The Volume Of The Book It Is Written Of Me—To Do Your Will, O God.' "

9 then He said, "Behold, I Have Come To Do Your Will, O God." He takes away the first that He may establish the second.

Everything the Lord Jesus said and did is an expression of the will of the Father. So, we can confidently follow Jesus and when we do, we are confident we are doing God’s perfect will.

The Lord Jesus – the Perfect Man, God’s prototype human – stepped into a fallen world and demonstrated to us how God wants us to live in a fallen world.

WHAT DID JESUS TEACH?



Mark 11:12-14,20-26

12 Now the next day, when they had come out from Bethany, He was hungry.

13 And seeing from afar a fig tree having leaves, He went to see if perhaps He would find something on it. When He came to it, He found nothing but leaves, for it was not the season for figs.

14 In response Jesus said to it, "Let no one eat fruit from you ever again." And His disciples heard it.

20 Now in the morning, as they passed by, they saw the fig tree dried up from the roots.

21 And Peter, remembering, said to Him, "Rabbi, look! The fig tree which You cursed has withered away."

22 So Jesus answered and said to them, "Have faith in God.

23 For assuredly, I say to you, whoever says to this mountain, 'Be removed and be cast into the sea,' and does not doubt in his heart, but believes that those things he says will be done, he will have whatever he says.

24 Therefore I say to you, whatever things you ask when you pray, believe that you receive them, and you will have them.

25 "And whenever you stand praying, if you have anything against anyone, forgive him, that your Father in heaven may also forgive you your trespasses.

26 But if you do not forgive, neither will your Father in heaven forgive your trespasses."

Have faith in God.

Speak to the mountain, command it to move, believe and you will see it moved.

Pray, believe that it is done, and you will receive.

Keep your heart clean (no unforgiveness, bitterness, pride, jealousy, anything that could hinder prayer).

WHAT DID JESUS DO?

Mark 4:35-41

35 On the same day, when evening had come, He said to them, "Let us cross over to the other side."

36 Now when they had left the multitude, they took Him along in the boat as He was. And other little boats were also with Him.

37 And a great windstorm arose, and the waves beat into the boat, so that it was already filling.

38 But He was in the stern, asleep on a pillow. And they awoke Him and said to Him, "Teacher, do You not care that we are perishing?"



39 Then **He arose and rebuked the wind, and said to the sea, "Peace, be still!"** And the wind ceased and there was a great calm.

40 But He said to them, **"Why are you so fearful? How is it that you have no faith?"**

41 And they feared exceedingly, and said to one another, **"Who can this be, that even the wind and the sea obey Him!"**

Jesus demonstrated what God wants us to do in a fallen world when we face winds and storms.

Jesus spoke to the wind and the sea commanding them to be still.

He challenged His disciples – and would challenge us today – why are you fearful. Where is your faith?

WHEN YOU FACE MOUNTAINS AND STORMS BRING YOUR FAITH IN GOD TO BEAR ON THE SITUATION

Have faith in God.

Speak to the mountain, the wind and the waves.

Pray and believe the work is done.

Keep your heart clean before God. (Remove unforgiveness, bitterness, pride, jealousy, anger, etc.)

This is a simple guide for use in Life Group discussions. Our objective is to focus on the application of the Sunday sermon - how each one is becoming a doer of the Word and building their life on God's Holy Word. The Life Group meeting would normally last for 1.5 to 2 hours. Each Life Group would have up to 12-15 people.

Preparation

Life Group Leader: To prepare for the Life Group meeting, you can listen to the Sermon or review the Sunday Sermon notes. Please do not make your life group read through the complete sermon notes during the life group. All you need to do is have individuals read the Scriptures listed below and then open for a time of discussion, sharing and learning using the questions given below. All these are available in the "All Peoples Church Bangalore" mobile App or online at our [sermons page](#). Pray for the Life Group meeting and invite the work and ministry of the Holy Spirit.

Welcome

The Life Group meeting may commence with a time of prayer, worship, and a fun activity.

LISTEN to God's Word

Read the following Scripture references: *1 Corinthians 15:45-49; Hebrews 10:5,7,9; Mark 11:12-14,20-26; Mark 4:35-41*

INVESTIGATE God's Word Together

Life Group is a discussion-based, participatory meeting with everyone given the opportunity to share their learning. Please discuss a few of these together, giving time for people to share their insights. We encourage each one individually to make notes of their personal learning during the Group discussion.

1, Based on 1 Corinthians 15:45-49, reflect on Jesus Christ as the last Adam, the second Man – God’s perfect prototype human, and that we are to bear His image, and be formed into His likeness. What does that mean to us practically in every day life.

2, Based on Hebrews 10:5,7,9 how can we learn to discover God's Will through closely following the life, teachings and ministry of the Lord Jesus?

3, Meditate on what the Lord Jesus taught us and demonstrated to us on what to do when we face mountains and storms based on Mark 11:12-14,20-26 and Mark 4:35-41.

Each one can take a few (3 minutes max) to share one or two key insights and how they see themselves applying it to their specific life situations. Encourage each one to participate and share.

FELLOWSHIP by sharing your life and spiritual journey

Each one takes a few (3 minutes max) to share anything from their walk with God, something God has been teaching them, a testimony of answered prayer or a specific challenge that they would like prayer for. Encourage each one to participate and share.

ENCOURAGE each other by praying and ministering to one another

Get into small groups of two or three and take turns to thank God and pray for each other in the light of what was learnt today. Listen to the Holy Spirit. Expect the gifts of the Holy Spirit to flow, bringing healing, releasing miracles, prophecy, etc.

Regroup and pray together for:

1, families to be protected and strengthened

2, a mighty outpouring of God's Holy Spirit on us as a church and through us to bless many others in our city and nation. Nothing but a mighty work of God's Spirit can change our city and nation.

3, for the BUILD TO IMPACT project - for all details to go well as we plan and build our Bible college and church facilities to serve the Lord and people.
