

**William Carey** 

### Father of modern Protestant missions (1761-1834)

- 1792 headed for India
- 1800 baptized first believer
- **1800 first Bengali New Testament**
- Next 28 years, he and his pundits translated the entire Bible into India's major languages
- 1818 founded Serampore College in , a divinity school for Indians spent 41 years in India without a furlough
